

**City of New Munich
October 7th, 2019**

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall. Jim Poepping, Shawn Duevel, Ron Doll, and Elmer Boecker were present. Pat Nathe was absent.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Elmer Boecker and carried the minutes from September 2019 were approved. Motion carried.

Allen Fielder was present to inform the Council of no medical call for the past month. Al mentioned they have a Fire Dept fundraiser with a gun raffle on Saturday, October 12th. All are welcome. Hydrants were flushed last month except for Munich street. Al had two bills to be paid both for NAPA, \$20.86 for supplies and \$294.10 for batteries.

Tom Valerius, Water/Waste Water Operator was present to inform the cemetery and ball field water will be shut off this month. MPCA came and inspected our property and we had very minor issues, we had problem with a badger digging holes by the pond. The nitrate levels are higher than allowed but it takes several years to level out, Tom is watching these numbers and they are slowing dropping. Stearns DHIA labs will no longer be taking wastewater samples, all samples will be going to Detroit Lakes to RMB Environmental Labs due to employee/license changes at Stearns DHIA labs. Tom is suggesting to the Council of placing some cameras by the ponds and dump stations. The Council will table until next meeting.

On a motion by Elmer Boecker, seconded by Ron Doll and carried the building permit for Barb Nathe were approved. Motion carried.

The Council has a resident that is past due, if no payment is paid by 10/21/19 the Council has agreed to shut off the resident's water. A letter was sent to the resident.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Elmer Boecker and carried the approval of R-Way Pumping will be the City's Snow removal as well as participating in the MN Dot Snow Removal Contract. Motion carried.

On a motion by Shawn Duevel, seconded by Elmer Boecker and carried the fund transfers, General fund and Fire fund pays \$2,500 each to the Fire Relief fund. This fund transfer is done each year. Motion was carried.

Leaf and grass pick up will be October 26th, leave bags open at end of driveways.
