Roads

The purpose of this report is to review our current status and to outline our goals of what is to be accomplished for the road rebuild project for this year.

The recent storms caused severe washout of many of the roads that had not yet been rebuilt. The good news is that the rebuilt roads have held up very well. We have some areas of the completed section that need to be seeded, and riprap added to some of those areas. All of our plans are weather dependent.

Here is an outline of where work will begin. This will incorporate regular road maintenance and the project:

- **Beach road around the lodge --** Work has already begun on the clearing of trees, and rebuilding of the roads leading in and out of the marina.
- **Seed and add riprap to areas of the completed project --** Because it was completed late in the season, certain areas have not been seeded yet.
- **Grade and add gravel to areas that have not yet been rebuilt --** Many areas of the roads that have not been rebuilt are in bad shape. We intend to grade those areas, add gravel where needed, and spray the hills. Many of the residents of the other side of the lake have not yet seen the benefits of the project. Even though we are planning to rebuild, we want the roads in decent shape before the season begins.
- **Finish the main road entering the lake --** Because this is the first impression when you enter the property and the fact that other areas have not shown negative effects of heavy machinery traveling over it, we have decided to complete this section.
- **Complete the section from the reservoir to the main road --** We are going to temporarily patch Williams Hill and return later to rebuild, because we are still in flux on our ability to use certain lots, and the amount of time and expense to do it right will bog down the project.
- **Start at the dam and work our way back towards Echo Hill --** This area has been broken down into smaller sections for planning purposes. It will be a challenge, as this is a heavily traveled road during the season. We will

Page 16

Prior to placing watercraft on Elk Lake waters, a copy of the current Registration Certificate must be presented to the Association Administration Office to confirm ownership and to confirm that the watercraft satisfies the Association's size limitations and allowable watercraft type. The Member must also present evidence of a minimum watercraft liability insurance of \$100,000.00 coverage prior to being issued the Elk Lake sticker. Prior to placing a boat on Elk Lake' water a sticker will be displayed on the watercraft.

Page 18

To preserve the use and enjoyment of Elk Lake for all Members and their Guests, the following types or categories of boats are permitted. All others are prohibited: ·

- *Mono- or single-hull boats, deck boats, typically fishing and pleasure/ski boats, with a twenty foot (20') **maximum** length; ·
- *Pontoon boats with a twenty-four foot (24') **maximum** length; ·
- *Sailboats (with the exception of the "Luck of the Irish" currently on Elk Lake and which is grandfathered with respect to these requirements) with a twenty foot (20') **maximum** length and twenty (20') maximum mast height; and ·
- * All other watercraft – twenty foot (20') **maximum** length.

(pg. 18 of Rules and Regulations continued)

Boat measurements for size purposes shall be from the front of the boat (bow) to the end of the boat (transom) or swim platform, without accounting for the motor. Boat measurements shall be controlled by the stated size on an official government issued bill of sale/proof of ownership or, in the case of controversy between the Member and the Association, by actual physical measure as taken by a Director or, at the Board's discretion, an independent third party appointed by the Board. Engine sizes must not exceed the maximum horsepower stated in the manufacturer's owners' manual. All engines of watercraft must have their exhausts muffled to prevent unnecessary noise.

No motorized personal watercraft of any type (e.g. jet skis) shall be allowed on waters of Elk Lake.

(Kentucky definition)"Personal watercraft" means a vessel which uses an internal combustion engine to power a jet pump for its primary source of propulsion and is designed to be operated by a person sitting, standing, or kneeling on the vessel rather than to be operated by a person sitting or standing inside the vessel.

Thunderstorm Safety – Avoiding a Lightning Strike

Warm weather usually means fun in the sun, but summer heat also can bring severe weather. Threatening thunderstorms often loom large on summer afternoons, so it's important to be prepared for downpours and accompanying lightning, which can strike outdoors or indoors. Consider the following suggestions when planning both outdoor and indoor events this summer to reduce the risk of a lightning strike.

- **Watch the weather.** Pay attention to your local weather forecast before participating in outdoor activities. If there's a chance of thunderstorms, consider rescheduling or moving events indoors. If that's not possible, have an emergency plan in place in case a severe storm rolls in and designate a sufficient nearby structure as an emergency shelter.
- **Stay inside.** If severe thunderstorms are imminent, go indoors and wait until they pass. Safe, enclosed shelters include homes, schools, offices, shopping malls and vehicles with hard tops and closed windows. Open structures and spaces do not provide adequate protection.
- **Duck and crouch.** If you're caught outside during a severe storm, it's important to crouch low on the ground, tuck your head and cover your ears to help protect yourself from harm. Do not lie down; lightning strikes can produce extremely strong electrical currents that run along the top of the ground, and laying horizontally increases electrocution risk.
- **Turn off faucets.** During a thunderstorm, lightning can sometimes be conducted through the plumbing. Avoid any type of contact with running water, including bathing, showering, and washing your hands, dishes, or clothes.
- **Turn off electronics.** All electrical appliances—televisions, computers, laptops, gaming systems, stoves, and more—that are plugged into an electrical outlet could carry a current from a lightning strike. Surge protectors will reduce the risk of damaging electronics.
- **Stay away from windows.** Not only is lightning a threat, but high winds and hail create flying debris that could be harmful during a thunderstorm. Close all windows and doors and keep away from them.

Roads continued

- try to keep closures to a minimum; however, during the week these areas will be closed.

Sensational Sirloin Kabobs

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 3 tablespoons light brown sugar
- 3 tablespoons distilled white vinegar
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic pepper seasoning
- 4 fluid ounces lemon-lime flavored carbonated beverage
- 2 pounds beef sirloin steak, cut into 1 1/2 inch cubes
- 2 green bell peppers, cut into 2 inch pieces
- skewers
- 1/2 pound fresh mushrooms, stems removed
- 1 pint cherry tomatoes
- 1 fresh pineapple - peeled, cored and cubed

Directions

1. In a medium bowl, mix soy sauce, light brown sugar, distilled white vinegar, garlic powder, seasoned salt, garlic pepper seasoning, and lemon-lime flavored carbonated beverage. Reserve about 1/2 cup of this marinade for basting. Place steak in a large re sealable plastic bag. Cover with the remaining marinade, and seal. Refrigerate for 8 hours, or overnight.
2. Bring a saucepan of water to a boil. Add green peppers, and cook for 1 minute, just to blanch. Drain, and set aside.
3. Preheat grill for high heat. Thread steak, green peppers, mushrooms, tomatoes, and pineapple onto skewers in an alternating fashion. Discard marinade and the bag.
4. Lightly oil the grill grate. Cook kabobs on the prepared grill for 10 minutes, or to desired doneness. Baste frequently with reserved marinade during the last 5 minutes of cooking.



THE SPEED LIMIT AT ELK LAKE IS 15 MILES PER HOUR

It's 15 for MANY reasons. The difference of a few miles per hour can mean the difference between life and death. The faster someone is driving, the **less time they have to stop** if something unexpected happens.

The law says . . . You must not drive faster than the speed limit for the **type of road** and your type of vehicle. Even though Elk Lake is private, we are still subject to the posted speed limit signs in the Lake.

Drive to suit the conditions of the road. In some road conditions, even driving at the speed limit could be too fast.

Consider the consequences of causing an accident due to driving at over the speed limit. If you cause an accident you will have to live with the emotional consequences of deaths or injuries caused to others. **Don't assume it's safe to break the speed limit on the lake roads because there is less traffic or an open road ahead.**

Be aware that there may be unexpected hazards, such as blind bends and hills, vehicles coming out of junctions, children playing and animals on the road.
