# June 19, 2016 Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 9:18-24

# "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it."

Imagine you were one of the disciples and heard Jesus say that. How would you react? You had listened to the wisdom of Jesus and seen how he cared for others and how they were cured because of their faith. You had seen people confess their sins and change their lives. You were with him when he was praying and heard him ask, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" After you and the other disciples mention several possibilities, Jesus mentions the "Son of Man," a reference to the "Messiah." Then Jesus says we cannot be so attached to life that we are afraid to lose it, and that if we lose our life for His sake, we will save it. Would you have continued to follow Jesus? We know at least twelve of his disciples continued to follow him. The eleven who remained after he was crucified and rose from the dead eventually understood and were willing to lose their life to imitate Jesus. Many of them did. Knowing that Jesus meant we cannot be so attached to life that we are afraid to lose it for imitating him, are we still willing to follow him?
