**BAPTISM STIPEND - \$25.00** - Baptisms are celebrated by appointment (after a Baptism Preparation Course has been completed).

**BAPTISM PREPARATION:** The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

**MARRIAGE STIPEND - \$200.00** - Please allow at least six months between the time of contacting the Parish and the date of the Marriage. A Marriage Preparation Course is required.

**FUNERAL STIPEND - \$200.00** - St. Joseph's Parish has a Bereavement Committee to assist with planning funeral services.

## HEARING ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

St Joseph's Church has an FM System installed which will allow those with hearing challenges to use the system in order to improve their ability to hear the readings and prayers. In order to use the system, you will need to obtain an FM receiver and either a headset or hearing loop from the Hospitality Ministry, when you enter the church. As we have limited numbers they will be issued on a first come basis.

**To use the headset,** plug it into the receiver and adjust the volume to a comfortable level.

**To be able to use the hearing loop,** you must have hearing aids that have a T-coil, and it needs to be activated by your hearing care professional if it is not. To determine whether you have T-coil or not, the model number for the hearing aids that have a T-coil installed will end with a T. The units must be returned immediately following the liturgy.

**OCTOBER 22 - WORLD MISSION SUNDAY:** At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. It is the responsibility of all Christian believers to spread the Gospel and to become involved in today's missionary work, thus sharing in the missionary activity of the Church. Simple ways to become involved are through prayer and through monetary donations. Each Christian community must "pray that the Lord's message may spread quickly and be received with honour" (2 Thess. 3.1). An understanding of the Church's mission should also lead us to give responsibly to the National Collection for World Mission Sunday (from which collection some of our Canadian dioceses still benefit). Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. **Please give generously.**

**OCTOBER 28 - FEAST OF SAINT SIMON AND SAINT JUDE, APOSTLES:** The names of Simon and Jude appear in New Testament lists of the apostles. Simon the Zealot is thus named because of his zeal for the law. Jude (Judas) is often referred to as Thaddeus or the son (or the brother) of James to distinguish him from Judas Iscariot. Jude is also known as a patron saint of 'hopeless cases'. Both these Apostles suffered martyrdom.



### DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE Stand for the Land Campaign (See display in foyer)

This Fall, we are continuing the **Create Hope: Stand for the Land** campaign. It will focus on communities in northern Honduras which are struggling to preserve their land and water, since an iron ore mine opened in the National Park, and is poisoning the rivers on which they depend for their livelihoods. Patricia Walsh-Warren, animator NL will visit our Church on **Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup> at the 5 p.m. Mass** and give a brief address. A petition signing in support of the Stand for the Land Campaign will be offered after the Mass.
