✓ Christ the King: Every year on the final Sunday in Ordinary Time the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Christ the King. The feast of Christ the King was added to the calendar of feasts by Pope Pius XI on December 11, 1925. The image of the Messiah King is everywhere in the Old Testament and Christians today hail Christ as King of the universe. The end of the Church year is a time to focus on the end of time. None of us knows whether the end of the world or the end of our life will come first, but from the perspective of our faith our preparation would be the same. Matthew's chapter 25 reaches its climax and conclusion with the scene of the last judgment. This judgment includes all humanity, and "the least" includes all the people who suffer distress of some kind. Therefore, at the end all humanity will be judged by the good done to poor and suffering people. Today's reading offers three significant messages:

• We are invited to recognize Christ's presence in the poor and the suffering.

• Rejecting the poor and suffering means rejection of Jesus himself.

• The criterion of judgment will be the mercy shown for the least of Jesus' brothers and sisters.
