This is a nice laid back affair with fellowship and games. This year marks our 100th anniversary so be sure to mark it on your calendars now and plan on attending.

I did get a few people who had suggestions for improving attendance at work details in the last month. These included mandatory work hours either for new or existing members (which I find distasteful) reduced dues for those who do show up, raffles for those who attend (we've done it before and we're going to try that again) and better communication. So expect the work details to be more prominently placed in the newsletters, and several emails reminding you of them.

Your 2023 dues will be the same as last year's and you can expect dues notices early this fall. We will be using the same system as last year. Each of you will have a contact person to mail your renewal form and payment to. Do not mail them to the chapter address and do not bring them to the meetings (it only delays and complicates things). Everyone who followed the directions we mailed with the dues notice received their card very quickly. We got a lot of positive feedback about that. Some people were not impressed with the late fee. The simple solution is to not mail your dues in late. It will be especially important to mail your dues in a timely manner this year. On December 31st your membership will expire if we haven't received your payment and you will not have access to the grounds, in addition to having to pay a \$25 late fee. The electronic gate will be active and without a valid code or active card will be denied. Initial activation is delayed, hence the side bar note.


