## FOOTBALL TIDBITS

#12 Michigan rolled over #15 Wisconsin, 38-13. The Wolverines piled up 320 rush yards, its most against an AP-ranked opponent since 2000 (341 against #19 Illinois).

lowa State upset #6 West Virginia 30-14. Iowa State now has 3 regular season wins against AP Top-6 teams since the start of last season, tied with Alabama and Auburn for most in the FBS. The Cyclones had 1 such win in program history before 2017.

#12 Michigan defeated #15 Wisconsin 38-13. Michigan running back Karan Higdon rushed for more than 100 for the 5th consecutive game, tied for the 2nd-longest streak by a Michigan player in the last 15 seasons. The Wolverines are now 10-0 when Higdon rushes for 100 yards.

Over the last 15 seasons, Tua Tagovailoa and Johnny Manziel are the only SEC QBs to throw at least 3 Pass TD in the 1st half of 3 straight conference games. Alabama has scored 30 points in the 1st half in 6 consecutive games, the longest streak in the FBS since Baylor from 2012-13.

#8 Penn State lost 21-17 against unranked Michigan State. It was Penn State's first loss as a ranked team against an unranked opponent since 2009 against lowa. The Nittany Lions had won 30 straight such games, which was the 2nd-longest active streak in FBS.

#13 LSU upset #2 Georgia, 36-16. That was LSU's largest win ever over an AP Top-2 team. LSU now has 3 wins as a Vegas underdog this season, matching its total from the previous 6 seasons combined.

#5 Notre Dame held off Pittsburgh, 19-14. Ian Book completed a career-high 81.3% of his passes (26-32) in the win. Book is the 3rd Notre Dame QB in the last 25 seasons to complete over 80% of his passes with at least 30 attempts, joining Brady Quinn and Everett Golson

#LSU led #2 Georgia 16-0 at the half. LSU has now won 41 consecutive games when leading by at least 16 points at halftime. The Tigers' last such loss came September 26, 2005 at home vs Tennessee.

Tennessee upset Auburn as a 15½ point underdog, tied for its second-biggest upset over the last 40 seasons. The Volunteers had lost 11 straight games against SEC teams prior to the win and hadn't defeated Auburn since 1999.

Two weeks ago, only one quarterback in Ohio State history had thrown for more than 400 yards in a game (Art Schlichter against Florida State in 1981). Dwayne Haskins has now eclipsed 400 passing yards in back-to-back games vs Indiana and Minnesota.

Florida had lost 26 straight games when trailing by 18 or more points until this past Saturday at Vanderbilt when the Gators over came a 21-3 deficit. The Gators last overcame a deficit that large on September 27, 2003 against Kentucky.

#### NC STATE AT CLEMSON



NC State (5-0) takes their perfect record into Death Valley to face the defending ACC Champions and undefeated Clemson Tigers (6-0) in a big ACC Atlantic Division clash. This game will kickoff at 3:30 EDT and will be televised on ABC.

Both the Wolfpack and Tigers were off this past weekend to prepare for this game. In our opinion, this game will come down to which team makes stops in the redzone. We're convinced each will be able to move the ball. It's whether they finish their drives with TD's or field goals is what will be the difference.

We're all aware of the Clemson quarterback situation. Freshman, Trevor Lawrence was able to beat out Kelly Bryant. # BRAGGING RIGHTS

## THE COACHING CAREER OF JOHN GAGLIARDI

John Gagliardi, who is the winningest coach in the history of college football passed away on October 7th. He was 91 years old. We decided to list his all-time coaching record. Gagliardi retired in 2012 after a record 64 seasons as a head coach, 60 of those at Saint John's, an all-male Roman Catholic private university with 2,000 students. He finished with 489 victories, 138 losses and 11 ties. He drew as much national attention for his laid-back approach to the sport back when most coaches were pushing their players to the limit. His policy was not to cut any players from the roster and not to hold practices longer than 90 minutes.


