BUMC Food Pantry is on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month from 9am–11:30am. Our Food Pantry continues to serve many families in our community twice a month with meats, breads, fresh produce (when available) and many pantry items. With the cost of food rising it is more difficult for families to buy enough food.

During April we provided food to over **425** people! We could not give this much without the support of BUMC and their donations of food items. Please continue to bring donations of any kind to the church office. Second Sunday is FOOD PANTRY SUNDAY! We need volunteers! Please consider becoming a volunteer once or twice a month.

This month we will be distributing food on May 11th and May 25th. Thank you so much for helping us to help others.



Open Table is serving delicious meals every Wednesday from 5–6pm. Our teams prepare wonderful well balanced meals every week. During the month of April **over 500** meals were served to people in our community! We are serving many more people and need extra help to lighten the work of our teams. Bring in your empty ink cartridges and we can turn them in for \$\$\$. We received a check for almost \$100 for the box that was recently sent in.

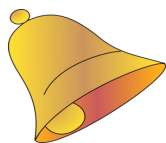
Bring in non-perishable items to help stock our Food Pantry so less money needs to be used to purchase food in order to distribute food twice a month to our community.
