The Vernon Cemetery is the final resting place of at least 77 people. This includes Revolutionary War Captain Richard Vernon (NC Militia), 5 Confederate Veterans and 32 Slaves. Jacob Johnson chose to clean up, restore and document the cemetery for his Eagle Scout project. This culminated with a Grave Dedication ceremony sponsored by the Andrew Crockett Chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution on 1 May 2016.

The work was completed by the boys of Boy Scout Troop 135, Jacob Johnson's family and friends and the Vernon brothers (Robert, Earl & Kevin). A special thanks to Mr. Torey Gaspie and Mrs. Tamera Swearingen for their assistance on this project.
