The Super Crew® Kid's Pumpkin Pancakes

INGREDIENTS

1 egg ¾ cup unbleached white flour

½ cup cooked pumpkin 1 tablespoon sugar

2 teaspoons baking powder ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon

A Pinch of nutmeg and powdered ginger 2 to 4 tablespoons vegetable oil, as needed

DIRECTIONS

Mix all ingredients (except oil) in a large bowl. Heat 1 teaspoon of oil in skillet. Add ¼ cup of pancake batter at a time, cooking until bubbles form around edges. Flip and cook 1 to 2 more minutes, until light golden. Repeat with remaining oil and batter. Then enjoy!

***Nutrition Tip: Orange foods, like pumpkin, are full of Vitamin A and beta-carotene. They keep your skin and eyes healthy. Beta-carotene helps you see in the dark.

Upcoming Events

Food Pantry Walk is an Annual Event at Sunrise. This year it will be held on Monday, November 14th. The children enjoy donating food items to families in Franklin, and they do a wonderful job walking to the Food Pantry. Once we arrive at the Food Pantry, a Food Pantry Volunteer gives a presentation on the history and the purpose of the Franklin Food Pantry. We unload our wagons and then we take the journey back to school with many of the older children riding in the wagons and the little ones very content to walk all the way back to the school. We do need adult volunteers to walk with us (and to sing). Join us if you can. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. If it is cool in the morning, please send in a pair of mittens and a hat. Also remind children to wear comfortable shoes – preferably sneakers. The Food Pantry isn't that far from the school, but along the way we want to make sure your children are comfortable.

Preschool Fair

The Preschool Fair (hosted by the Franklin MOMS Club) will be held Tuesday, November 15th at the Norfolk Public Library from 5:00 – 7:00pm. If you have a neighbor or friend looking for information on preschools, then this is the fair to attend. Sunrise will have a table this evening as well, and we will answer any questions families have about Montessori Education and our school. Typically the preschool fair encourages families to visit our school for observations or to come to our Open Houses in January and February.

Picture Day is Wednesday, November 16th – just in time for the holiday season. Please return your packets by Tuesday, November 15th – so we can hand them to Mr. Vicario as he takes each child's picture. If you just want a class picture only, please let your child's Lead Teacher know. The cost of one classroom picture is \$9.00.

Thanksgiving Feast is on Tuesday, November 22nd. This is when both classrooms will come together to share food with each other. Every child from Sunrise is invited to the Thanksgiving Feast. The children will be making and baking their food. This year they will be making apple sauce, butter and baking corn bread. Served with the food that they make will be a choice of water or apple cider. Place mats and name tags will also be made by the classrooms.

Tuesday, November 29th A representative from the MA Department of Early Education and Care will be coming to renew our license. Our Licensor will be with us all day, and she will check that everything is up to date and in order; this includes medical forms, including vaccinations (or exemptions) and lead screening. If I have given you reminder notes, please complete this request before November 29th. Also, whenever your child goes for an annual wellness physical, the school needs to have a copy of the most recent form on file. Thank you.
