Obese white female, 5' 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", estimated weight 220 lbs. Hair is light brown. Irides - left is blue and right is hazel. Teeth are in good condition.

There is a cluster of stabwounds in the left upper chest which consist of 16 stabwounds in an area measuring 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " horizontally and 5" vertically; these extend from just over the outer third of the left clavicle to the midline, some along the clavicle and some just below; they all are of equal size, measuring approximately 1/2" - some are vertical and some are horizontal.

At the same level to the right of the midline lying 2" away are two stabwounds, each are of the same size.

There are 2 stabwounds 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " medial to the acromio-clavicular articulation and these are of the same size. Medial to these two at the base of the neck there is a third stabwound/just below the angle of the jaw on the neck are 2 similar stabwounds. There is an incised wound extending from the tip of the left ear along the mandible which measures 1" in length.

In the mid portion of the insertion of the deltoid muscle on the left side there is a 1/2" stabwound.

On the left side 3" above the costal margin 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the left of the midline is another stabwound of equal size.

2" anterior to the right acromio-clavicular articulation is a stabwound measuring 1/2".

Slightly to the back of the shoulder there is a large wound which lies 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " posterior to the right acromio-clavicular articulation and this measures 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and extends deep into the muscle in a downward direction for a distance of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

On the left side of the upper lip overlying the left medial incisor is a cut measuring 3/8" and there are abrasions at the inner canthus of the right eye and along the right eyebrow. There is also a large excoriation extending from the lateral epicondyle of the right humerus traversing diagonally across the back of the forearm for a distance of 4".

On the left hand 1" below the ulnar styloid is a horizontal stabwound which measures 5/8" and which is superficial to the underlying fifth metacarpal bone.

On the right hand in the mid portion of the thenar eminence is an incised wound just involving the epidermis which measures 3/4" in length.

On the back there is one stabwound at the base of the neck lying 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the left of the midline, one at the midline situated over the spine at approximately the first thoracic vertebra and one lying just lower down than this 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right of the midline; these wounds are the same size as the others.

The stabwounds in the neck are seen to penetrate through the subcutaneous tissues along the larynx and to reach the spine; however, these do not touch the carotids or subclavian veins although one goes between both structures. Many of the stabwounds of the anterior chest go through the ribs and intercostal spaces and they penetrate into the lungs; in the right lung in the lower part of the upper lobe there are six stabwounds; in the right middle lobe there are four stabwounds; some of these are the same track as the overlying lobe; there are also cuts along the surfaces of the lung where the knife has cut the underlying pleura and parenchyma. In the left lung there is one stabwound in the upper part of the lower lobe which penetrates only a short distance into the pleura. There are also two stabwounds of the heart, one in the upper part of the right ventricle and one in the lower part near the apex. As a result of these wounds there is 1400 c.c. of blood in the left chest cavity and 350 c.c. of blood in the right chest cavity; there is 150 c.c. of blood in the pericardial cavity.

PRIMARY INCISION: Pericardium adiposis measures 9 cm.

CIRCULATORY SYSTEM: The heart weighs 350 grams. Epicardium and endocardium smooth. Myocardium firm, red brown. Valves unremarkable. Coronary arteries thinned. Mild aortic arteriosclerosis.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: Lungs weigh 650 grams. Mildly emphysematous. Bronchioles, bronchi, trachea negative.

G.I. TRACT:

BILIARY SYSTEM:

Stomach contains a quart of partially digested food. Liver weighs 2400 grams. Soft and shows fatty metamorphosis; is also pale as are all the organs.

SPLEEN:

Spleen weighs 280 grams. Soft, pale pulp.

PANCREAS:

Nothing noteworthy.

GENITO URINARY SYSTEM:

Kidneys weigh 300 grams. They are very pale; good cortico medullary differentiation. Calyces, pelves, ureters and bladder negative. Bladder contains about 100 c.c. of clear urine. Uterus, tubes, ovaries are atrophic.

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM: Reflecting the scalp reveals 3 stabwounds in the anterior parietal region; the cuts above these are large measuring $1\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1" in length and there are defects in the skull just involving the outer table. In the left temporal region there is a cut in the temporal muscle through a stabwound in the scalp and also a defect just above this in the skull from a stabwound of the scalp - none of these wounds penetrate the skull although they nick the outer table. Brain weighs 1250 grams. Arteries at the base thinned. Sectioning reveals nothing further.

CAUSE OF DEATH: MULTIPLE STABWOUNDS OF CHEST, NECK,

HEAD, LUNGS AND HEART; HEMOPERICARDIUM;

HEMOTHORACES; HOMICIDAL.

CLOTHING. Clothing consists of a green house dress with white pattern; pair of blue pants; the house dress shows numerous cuts corresponding to stabwounds on the body - considerably soaked with blood.


