THE HOLY TRINITY

Know, and fix in your heart, that the LORD is God. (Deuteronomy 4: 39)

What a beautiful reading for today's feast of the Holy Trinity! Moses' words to the Israelites tell us that there is only one God: "the Lord" (Deuteronomy 4: 39). And he is a wonderful God! He is a generous and kind, not like the false gods that the pagans worshipped. He is so kind, in fact, that he rescued his people from slavery and led them into the Promised Land (Deuteronomy 4:34). No pagan could say anything like that about their "god"!

Now, with the coming of Christ, we have an even greater understanding of who this one true God truly is. And at the heart of that understanding is the proclamation that our God is a Trinity of Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

As *Father*, he treats us with great love and calls us into his family. He welcomes us into his throne room and promises to hear from us when we call to him.

As *Son*, he takes on our own humanity and offers that humanity in sacrifice on a cross, he destroys the power of sin and showers us with mercy.

As *Spirit*, he pours his very life and love into us. He empowers us to live the life we've been called to—a life of love and mercy that mirrors the love of our heavenly Father.

This is our God! But we live in a world that tempts us to make false gods and riches and self-indulgence and to be indifferent to the needs of the poor. These "gods" aren't real; all they can promise are fleeting pleasures. By contrast, the one true God loves us unconditionally and wants to save us and care for us. So follow Moses' advice and "fix in your heart" the

truth that you belong to God- and he belongs to you (Deuteronomy 4:39)!

"Almighty God, Father, Son and Spirit, may you be praised and worshipped for all eternity!"

NEXT SUNDAY: CORPUS CHRISTI



The year 1264 saw the proclamation of a new feast for the Church.

Years before, a holy nun had received a dream indicating the need for this feast. Various delays slowed its institution, until a Eucharistic miracle in 1263 finalized the Church's decision to declare the feast. Its lovely Office—admired to this day—was written by St. Thomas Aquinas.

This feast is what we all know as Corpus Christi—the Feast of the Body of Christ.

Like the three previous feasts of Easter, Pentecost, and Trinity Sunday, Corpus Christi solemnly celebrates one of the fundamental mysteries of the Church.

In the celebration of this feast, we honor Jesus as He is among us in the Holy Eucharist. The feast focuses specifically on "transubstantiation," the miracle of the "change of substance" which the bread and wine undergo at Consecration.

The Church chose to set the feast on a Thursday because that is the day on which the first Mass was sacrificed. Just as every Sunday is a mini-celebration of the Resurrection, so every Thursday reflects the first Consecration.

Today, we adore Jesus—truly Emmanuel, *God with us*, through the Eucharist—telling Him with jubilation and solemnity how much we love Him.
