

New Vienna City Council Meeting  
June 5,2018

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the special meeting at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, Jim Naber, T.J. Kloser Kathy Engelken. Absent-Mike Leuchs

Kloser made the motion to approve the agenda for June 5,2018 seconded by Naber.

Naber made the motion to approve the consent agenda, second by Kloser.

Veteran Memorial Committee present to give an update on the project. Jerry Westhoff informed council that they hope to start with concrete work this month, brick work in July. The committee had plans and drawings to show what the space will look like. The council was very pleased in the layout and design.

Mayor Pat Hermsen called out on a fire call at 5:42pm and Mayor Pro tem Langel took over the role as Mayor for the duration of the meeting.

Liquor license for J & D Mart and VFW Club was approved on a motion from Naber, second by Kloser.

Building permit for Dennis Wedewer for a 10x12 storage shed for his back yard was approved pending Mile Neuhaus looking int placement of this building on the property in regards to the property lines and easements. Motion from Kloser, second by Naber.

Discussion on the trees in town, council stated that the trees on the resident's property between the curb and sidewalk are the responsibility of the homeowner to maintain.

Mike Neuhaus stated that a sewer line on Washington may have to get televised and jetted, Mike stated that we needed to see what was going on with this line.

Manhole by Elmhurst may need to be addressed as it has washout and a hole in that area.

Fire Station updates, the Mayor stated we are still moving forward with this and trying to get our options laid in place to proceed with this project. We will be meeting with an architect and the city attorney to get plans in motion.
