How Does Home Studios Work?

We send a trained art instructor to a home (or business, daycare, etc.), which means you can either:

- host a class (We suggest you find 5 friends or neighbors to join you)
- find a friend who is willing to host, and join their class

Hosting a class is easy! Fill out this page and see "Reservation" section on the following page. Once your date is confirmed and your deposit is received, we will email you a flyer that you can distribute by print or email to your friends. Then just provide a room with a table. We will bring a plastic tablecloth and all supplies. Then we'll clean up after class so you can't tell we were there.

1. Choose a Theme

Using step-by-step demonstrations, participants are guided through fun and educational projects designed around the theme you choose. **Choose one from our Course Themes flyer.** We have over 30 to choose from, including a Vacation Bible School. 2. Choose 2 Mediums Circle one or two of the following:

chalk pastels • watercolor crayons • watercolor paints • oil pastels • colored pencils • clay*

** Clay: Be aware that we use Sculpey modeling clay which is not messy like traditional clay, but small pieces may roll onto the floor. Projects need to be baked in your oven for 5-10 minutes. Students may paint them at their own homes.*

3. Choose a Time Slot

Each Summer Adventure is designed as 2-hour lessons for four consecutive days, Monday through Thursday. Dates will book on a first-come, first-served basis so book as early as possible. Check more than one choice in case your first is already taken. (You may number them in order of your preference.) We may be able to adjust the times or add options, so let us know if you have a special request. If you prefer a once a week option, contact us to discuss.

All options listed below are Monday through Thursday (4 consecutive days). Depending on the week, there is a morning and/or afternoon time slot:

MORE SUMMER ADVENTURES DETAILS:

Class Size

Suggested 6-10 students. We will come for a smaller group but fee will be based on a 6 student minimum.

Cost per Student (for 1 Summer Adventure which is 4 two-hour lessons)

Tuition: \$99 per student

Material fee: \$5 (or if you selected clay as one medium, it is \$8 including 1 clay project)

Discount for Host

One student will receive the following discount depending on class size:

- \$10 off a class of 6 students
- \$25 off a class of 7 students
- \$50 off a class of 8 students
- \$75 off a class of 9 students
- **FREE tuition & materials if you host a class of 10 students! (Save \$104 or \$107)**

Reservation Steps

1. **Send in your request:** Fill out page 1 of this form and email, fax or mail it. (Contact information at bottom of page 1)

We will respond to you within one business day to let you know if the dates you requested are available and we will email you the registration form.

2. **Register:** Reserve the class by mailing your registration form and a \$50 non-refundable deposit* (which will be applied to the host's tuition). If you prefer to pay the deposit by credit card, you may enter your card information on the registration form we will send you and then email or fax it.

3. **Final Payment:** The final balance** for a minimum of six students is due two weeks before class begins or your reservation cannot be guaranteed.

* If you have a class of 9 or 10, the applicable portion of this \$50 deposit will be returned to honor the Host discount.

**If more students join after payment is made, a refund will be given to honor the Host discount.
