Designed for accessibility,EasyReader enables blind and partially sighted readers to read with magnified text, audio, or a combination of both - where each word is highlighted on screen as it's read aloud. It also links to braille displays for braille readers.

EasyReader provides global access to millions of books from accessible book libraries around the world. Text magnification in EasyReader is easy to adjust. Simply pinch in and out on the screen to find the text size that's best for you.

Listen to narrated audio books or listen to text-only books and newspapers, which EasyReader converts to human-sounding synthesized speech. Audio perfectly synchronizes with on-screen text highlights, so you can read along as you listen.



MyTalk Tools Mobile

MyTalk Tools app is an augmentative alternative communications (AAC) app that is suitable for children with communication difficulties. It helps children with Down syndrome, Cerebral Palsy, hearing or visual impairments, autism or other conditions that hinder communication ability.

MyTalk Tools allows users to express themselves using a sequence of words, sounds and images, text, and text-to-speech. Users can customize the app to view only certain images and play certain sounds that are best suited for them. It helps them to child communicate better.
