Season 8 (2022 - 2023)

Attire Options

Dancers (All program levels)

Hair: Must be gathered and pulled away from the face but in a style of your choice of braids, bun, or ponytail.

Attire: Leotard & tights

No specific colors are required but this allows students to focus on skills within classes without their clothes moving around/body parts being exposed. Leotards may be complemented with leggings, ballet skirts, and/or dance shorts to be worn on top of the leotard so long as it is form-fitting.

Male/Non-Binary (All program levels)

Hair: Long hair must be gathered and pulled away from the face but in a style of your choice of braids, bun, or ponytail.

Attire: Form-fitting t-shirts and/or bottoms

T-shirts should be fitted or long enough to be able to be tucked in

Dance belts/athletic compression will be recommended for male dancers over the age of 10

Unacceptable Attire

Students not in proper attire will have to change prior to class.

Parents will be notified that their student is not dressed properly and they have the following options:

- 1) Purchase dancewear from Edgez Dance
- 2) Take their student home and schedule a makeup class (if makeup classes are permitted)
