#### God of the Impossible By Art L.

It is with prayerful consideration that I sit and write these few words. It is my desire to impart unto the brothers and sisters who are a part of the body, and the Torronters for Official family, as well as all those who are blessed with the newsletters, a word of encouragement.

Regardless of whether we are free men and women or prisoners we are all faced, at one time or another, with the disappointments of life. I have been serving God for a good number of years. In those years I have seen personal failure, and I have seen great victory's by the hand of the Lord.

The one thing that I have learned is simply this; in times of difficulty, in times of trial, or at the crossroads of decision, this too is simply the greatest thing that I can do is go back! Return to the fundamentals and the foundations of my faith. These are two Scriptures that come to mind. Matthew 6:33, "Seelt ye first the hingdom of God and His rightsourness, and all these things will be added unto you."

This is very fundamental to me because it is the very first verse I ever memorized. I suppose that it is so because there was an old song that quotes that very verse. Still, as fundamental as it is to me, it holds deep spiritual significance. The second Scripture that comes to mind when I find myself digging deep into the fundamentals of my faith comes from Proverbs 3:5-6, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your path straight."

I do not expect that this will be a heavy 'Revy' (revelation) to most of us. Still, many times in the heat of the battle, we as saints, lose sight of the very simple truths of His Word, for all our high minded thoughts, often we can miss God's direction. In my heart of hearts I know that the will of God and the mind of God are far too complex for me to ever fully comprehend. Still I know that His love for me is unfailing and He will reveal it to me, what I need for the hour, and provide for the need at hand. So I find no need to complicate my walk with Jesus, but only to keep it simple.

Excessive incarceration will definitely make a man or woman a lil' quirky. More than once I have been approached by someone who has asked me, "Brother, are you alright?" I just smile and say, "Sure I am! I'm just encouraging myself in the Lord! This is one thing that I learned many years ago. Hebrews 4:12 tells us, "For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

In *Ephesians 6:17* Paul refers to the Word of God as the sword of the Spirit. Paul's reference is likening the Word of God to an offensive weapon with which to do our warfare. As you all well know, my brothers and sisters, we are definitely in a spiritual war, in accordance with *Ephesians 6:10-12*, "*Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."* 

Jesus is our example of using the Word of God to combat the enemy. In *Matthew Chapter 4* Jesus was confronted and tempted by the devil. This was just after He was baptized by John and sent into the wilderness. The devil came at Him sideways. The devil first tried to bribe Him, then he tried to put Jesus in a trick bag by even perverting the Scriptures. How many of you know that the enemy often tries to throw you a curve ball by mixing in a little bit of truth with a lie, just to try to make you take the bait? In *Matthew 4:4*, 7, 10 we clearly see how Jesus responds to the enemy of our souls, "It is written word! Nothing more, nothing less! *Romans 3:3-4* tells us, "What if some do not have faith? Will their lack of faith nullify God's faithfulness? NOT AT ALL! Let God be true, and every man a liar." Again, His Word is quick and powerful! His Word in brief will say it all, when I for many ways am inadequate outside of Christ.

So let's go back to encouraging myself; I have learned this over the years. Just as my Savior used the written Word of God three different times to combat the enemy of our souls, so must I do likewise because He is our example. If we are Christians are we not to be like Him? So, as He does we do likewise!

So in times of distress or concern I've taken to standing in agreement with and quoting Scriptures out loud. I begin by taking the Word of God and making it personal like in 1 John 4:4, "(I am a child of God's, and have overcome the world), because the One that is in me is greater than the one that is in the world", "In ALL things (I am) more than a conqueror through Him Who loves (me)." (Romans 8:37), "I can do EVERYTHING through Him who gives me strength." (Philippians 4:13), and my all time favorite is Isaiah 54:17, "No weapons formed against you (me) shall prosper, and every tongue that shall rise against you (me) in judgment shall you (I) condemn. This the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of Me, saith the Lord."

If we will be honest with ourselves we must admit that there are times when the enemy comes at us with doubt, fear, and uncertainty and we often feel the temptation to take the bait while setting the hook ourselves. I for one have found using Jesus' example of using the Word of God to combat the enemy in all my doubts and fears to be very effective. Knowing His Word and believing it enables us to stand IN HIM!

Today I am reading in Joshua Chapter 10 and I encourage you all to read it for yourselves. In this particular portion of the Scriptures Joshua does something very profound to me. In the midst of a battle Joshua asked the Lord to cause the sun and the moon to stand still so that he could continue to do warfare (Joshua 10:12). One could read that and say, "Come on Joshua, that's just crazy! Don't you know anything about science? How's that going to happen?" Whether someone believes it or not Joshua 10:13 goes on to say, "So the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, till the nation avenged itself on its enemies ... The sun stopped in the middle of the sky and delayed going down about a full day."

You see friends; we serve a God whom in all things are possible. "For NOTHING is impossible with God." (Luke 1:37) Brothers and sisters we have to learn His Word and learn to use it as a weapon of our warfare. I pray these words of encouragement will be helpful to someone out there as we all remember Hebrews 10:23, "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He who promised IS FAITHFUL." Let me share Hebrews 10:23 - from the Message Translation Bible, "So let's do it - full of belief, confident that we're presentable inside and out. Let's keep a firm grip on the promises that keep us going. He always keeps His word."

#### Testimony from the Outside ... A Mothers Heart and Perspective By Teri B.

Dearest Ontromers for Official, my son has continually shared his love for this print and contributed his perspective from time to time. Always expressing his love for Christ.

I felt lead to share my story even if I am not behind the scenes. My son has a bit less than 2 years to the gate and we praise Jesus for all He has done in our lives! If there are any moms out there that are having doubts, may your hope be restored.

Having lived through my son's drug addiction and coming out on the other side of the pain, it's worth sharing. The writing of this story is therapeutic as well as healing. Mostly, it is necessary for me to tell other mother's that, "God does a more sufficient job of clearing the way." After many hours of deliberations and consultations with God, it was clear what had to be done. His guidance penetrates much deeper and more spiritual than anything I am capable of expressing. My son and I became estranged and in 2004, I literally handed him to his heavenly Father and prayerfully asked for help.

Some drug addicts do not act out while under the influence. Some do. Some behave just as irresponsible as a Lab monkey on drugs. They become a prisoner behind their lies, shame, deception and doubt. In this case, a prisoner behind the bars of incarceration, lies, shame, deception and doubt. It was during the years of our separation that God worked His miracle. He gave my son all that he needed. He poured out and covered him with His Mercy and Grace. It was like a revelation had to occur. And it did! Could it be supernatural? You better believe it!!

I had not talked to my son in about 9 years. During which hard work was done. In 2012, I received a letter from my son. The return address was closer than where I had heard he was serving a 9 year sentence. The letter was GREAT! He essentially asked if I would consider coming to the prison for a face to face visit. Big changes had taken place and he was in the midst of obtaining a college degree in Seminary. Translated: He was to be a pastor. WOW!! A visit?! In all of the insanity and years of prison life, I had never participated. I had made that point super clear very early on. Why would I want to go to a prison? It wasn't my sentence, my actions or choices, right? No, thank you. Well, the Lord had a different plan. He revealed to me that I could do this. The same God that gave me the courage to let go and let Him handle my son's journey, inspired me to agree to a face to face visit. Again, WOW!!

It was one of the most amazing days of my life! I hated it so much! But, when my son walked through the door to the visitation area, I knew the pain was gone. The man, who walked towards me with open arms, was exactly what I had been waiting for, all of those years. We hugged and wept. The separation was over. We both realized we would never again have to reunite. The word 'clarity' is a good description of our feelings. We laughed, cried, talked, shared and repeated that about a dozen times. The experience of passing all of the rules and regulations was miserable! I was extremely self-concerned and freaked out until I learned the horror of what my son endured after our visit was over and he disappeared behind those doors.

I would like everyone to lift my uncle, Jim, and his family up in prayer. He has been battling lung cancer for two years, and recently the cancer has moved to his liver. He is going to start aggressive rounds of chemotherapy. I believe in the power of prayer and the supernatural healing for Jim. I know that You answer prayers. I believe in miracles" ... I have always said that my family's genes are strong and defy medical logic ... my mom had lived longer than doctors ever said she would, she had severe breathing problems since childhood; my grandpa had been shot in the war, electrocuted, brain aneurysm, and heart by-pass surgery, another uncle who was in a severe motorcycle accident and was in a coma, and now my uncle, Jim, who will also defy the odds like his sister, father, and brother. God is faithful, He is good and He is our healer ... Exodus 15:26 says that God is our healer and our life giver ...

I'd like to make a special request if I may that you and your church family pray for my children, that soon we will be reunited and that the guardian angels keep and protect them from any harm! This six year sentence is almost over for me and what a devastating time it has been - I lost my father at age 60, my mother at age 57 and my grandfather at age 80. Both my parents went early in age because of drugs and the lifestyle they chose. I'm left with beautiful memories. Sometimes it doesn't feel real, I know deep down this painful experience is going to always remind me of how helpless and reliant I have been on our Savior Jesus Christ! He is my strong tower ... Praise the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior; may God, our Savior Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit keep blessing you all and our brothers and sisters at the Overcomers for Efrist; Praise the Lord God Almighty. Thank you from the bottom of my heart, I really needed that spiritual Lift up, especially after my aunt passing away. Thank you for all your prayers, love and support. I got released on a program which put me out 90 days early. I had to go to class for 12 classes. The program is Sage – it was good, I enjoyed it. #### Right Where I Was By G.B.B.

First I want thank you for your card and your words. All of you at the Operations for Official mean so much to me, for reals. From the time when my wife and three daughters were killed by a drunk driver, over these last eight years, my faith has honestly grown. I remember the night I found out about them being killed. I was locked up and I remember wanting to give up on life. But God came to me right in my cell. I remember God letting me hear my family tell me that everything was going to be okay. And you know what? Everything has been as they said! Sure there have been some tough times here on the inside but I've pushed on. Besides you all at the OCAC there is one other newsletter that writes me and to be honest with you, I have never been so blessed as when I found you all's newsletter. I used to be a very hard man. Not to my family but to others. I never let anyone talk down to my wife and kids and I never talked down to them either.

Here are a few places that I've been studying over the past few days. I hope all of the Overcomers will enjoy them and get revelation like I have. In 2 Timothy 1:7 the Word tells us, "For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love and self-discipline." Now look closely at 1 Samuel 16:14 where it says, "But the Spirit of the Lord departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the Lord troubled him." What I saw here was that the spirit that left Saul was probably not the Holy Spirit but instead the royal anointing of God. Why? Well because the indwelling Holy Spirit secures and empowers all believers and that is not what was going on here in this Scripture. Next, even though God does have dominion and authority over demons that is NOT the God we serve. Instead it could have been a spirit of depression that came over Saul. Listen to what Jesus had to say about whether God would be involved in such a thing, in Luke 11:14-28, but in particular Verses 24-26. "When an impure spirit comes out of a parson, it goes through arid places souting rost and does not find it. Then it says, I will return to the house I loft." When it arrives, it finds the house swept clean and put in order. Then it goes and takes seven other spirits more wisked than itself, and they go in and two there. And the final condition of that parson is worse than the first." Now honestly you can see God had nothing to do with orchestrating this condition.

I'll close with Hebrews 13:20-21, "Now may the God of peace, Who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing His will, and may He work in us what is pleasing to Him, through Jesus Christ, to Whom be glory forever and ever. Amen."

I believe I'm on the right path now, but I need to start spreading His Word more and reach out to share what I have. The majority of the people I mix with either on the basketball court or in passing are gangbangers, active gangbangers. Most of them are good people and some are even my friends. In fact I'm an ex-gangbanger. Most of them are strong willed and are 'self' dependant or survival type people, and Jesus is opposite of that. Sometimes I tell them that Jesus loves them. Other times I tell myself, "I'll just let them see my joy, my attendance at church and my positive attitude. Hopefully my words and my patience will be my testimony." And nine times out of ten I leave it at that. But I know I need to do more.

I've been saved since 2004 but honestly this is the first time I have ever studied the Word. There is a huge, HUGE difference between sitting and listening to a pastor preach and actually sitting down and searching the Scriptures. I feel I'm still a baby in Christ and I do thank God for the motivation He gives me to seek Him. It used to seem like a hassle or a burden. I know that I don't have too, and today it's great because I TRULY WANT TOO and I thank God every day for this new desire to know Him!

I heard a pastor the other day say, "If your left hand hurts, thank God that your right hand doesn't!" That's important, we must remember to thank God for the blessings that we have because not only is it right, but when we receive more blessings it will be like 'icing on the cake'. My material blessings are few and far between in here due to the lack of things I can have and I know it's hard on everyone in here, so stay strong.

I also heard from a friend I grew up playing baseball with, and I got goose bumps! Jesus Christ is real!! I no longer base my beliefs on what I get, but instead on what Jesus has already done! This is a major learning experience I just recently

got. I used to think, "Well, if I don't have this or that, I must be doing something wrong." But I now know that true joy comes from what He has ALREADY done; we have eternity.

#### SNAP

First I want to thank all of you at the Oc+C for continuing to send me your newsletters every month. I know that you all put forth a great deal of effort in order to make that happen.

I was reading the June and July issues of the newsletter where I came across the testimony about your accident. After reading it I felt the urge to share my own testimony with all of you. My testimony also came in the form of a motorcycle accident. So here it goes.

Somewhere in mid-November of 2010, I had a 1979 Yamaha 1100 Super Deluxe. I loved that bike. Since there is not a mandatory helmet law in Arizona and only eye protection, I always chose to wear the safety glasses that I also used at my day job as a sheet metal fabricator. I didn't even own a helmet. One night after work a friend of mine asked me if I would be willing to help him pull the engine out of a Ford Taurus over the weekend. I said, "Sure, I love to turn wrenches!"

I was ready and waiting at his house the morning the engine removal was to take place. I left my motorcycle at his house on 15th Ave. and Peoria, and rode with him to his dad's house at 43rd Ave. and Thomas where the Taurus was. On the way there we came across a church that was having a yard sale of donated items. As we approached the church I seen a motorcycle helmet sitting on the ground and yelled for my friend to, "PULL OVER!" So he did.

Honestly, I didn't really want the helmet to wear but only to have just to say, "Yes I do have a helmet." As I walked over to pick it up I was looking around until I spotted a volunteer helping with the sale. I seen a young lady and asked her, "How much is this helmet?" She replied, "Five dollars." So I quickly said, "I'll take it!" Then my friend and I continued on our journey to remove that engine.

Once we arrived where the car was we got right to work. In just a short amount of time my friend started hooking up the chains for the cherry picker as I got underneath to remove the bolts from the motor mounts. Once the engine was loose we started to remove it from the engine compartment and immediately noticed there were some brake lines going to the master cylinder that were in the way and needed to be removed. So I did just that.

My friend's 5 year old son loved to play with glasses of any type and occasionally he broke them. Since I only had one pair with me I decided I'd better keep them, on top of my head. Once the brake lines were detached I crawled under the car again with a crowbar to help guide the motor out while my friend continued to raise it with the cherry picker. It was during this process that I heard a 'SNAP' on top of my head. At first I thought it was dirt clods or something of that nature falling that was until I moved a little more and discovered one of my safety glass lenses laying on my chest. After a quick examination I realized the 'SNAP' I heard was the frame of my glasses. Evidently what happened was a drop of brake fluid had fallen directly on the frame causing a chemical reaction and weakening them until they 'snapped'.

After we had finished the job there that day we went back to my friend's house where I left my bike. I had a girlfriend that lived right there in the area and we had already made plans to hang out that evening. Since the only pair of glasses I had with me had gotten broken, which was my eye protection, earlier in the day ... the only choice I had was to wear the helmet with a face shield that I had gotten earlier that day. I said my goodbyes and fired up my bike and headed west-bound on Peoria Ave. towards 35th Ave. I had no idea what was soon to come.

As I approached 19th Ave., the light was green so I proceeded towards the intersection. There was a truck facing east in the turn lane, and before I knew it he turned left right in front of me. I had NO time at all to avoid the truck and smashed right into the center of his axle at about 45 mph. His truck spun out three times until it finally hit a light pole in front of the Churches chicken place. I flew off the bike and was airborne for close to 100 feet. I hit the ground so hard that the helmet popped off. But before it did it took the initial impact and saved my life.

I was rushed from the accident to John C. Lincoln Hospital where they soon diagnosed that I had broken my pelvis on both sides. I was placed in ICU. After two days Access insurance refused to cover any more expense at which point I was basically kicked out of the hospital. After I left the hospital I did do physical therapy for quite some time. Although it has now been close to 5 years since that accident I am still trying to get surgery for some internal injuries from that crash. Other than that, I am pretty much healthy by all other accounts.

It took me quite some time of reflecting on the matter to realize that had anything different happened that day, I would have most likely been wearing safety glasses that evening and most likely would NOT have survived that crash. I believe that the Lord was there that day and had the helmet put there at the church yard sale where I could see it for my protection. I later did some research on the HJC (brand of helmet I had bought), which by the way was brand new, and found that that particular helmet was priced at around \$400. So you tell me, does the Lord work in mysterious ways or what?
