Player/Parent Contract Due March 1, 2019

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General Information:

- Communication is EXTREMELY important. If you are unable to attend a game, please notify coaches in advanced.
- All players are required to accept and keep up with their TeamSnap in order to receive important information on practice/game changes throughout the season.
- Come prepared for practice and games. Bring goggles, mouthguard, cleats, tennis shoes, snack and water!
- Gatorade bottle is required at each practice! If the athlete does not have the water bottle present at practice the team will do 10 pushups for each player who does not have it.
- Nutrition is VERY important! You must EAT to have fuel to practice and compete at your best!
- Pay attention to all announcements made by the coaches and captains.
- Be on time to all practices and games! Tardiness affects the entire team. It is your responsibility to find a ride to all practices and games.
- Support one another during practice and games.
- Grades are VERY important! Please work hard to keep up with projects and assignments. Ineligible athletes are still expected to attend practice and games unless worked out with your coach.
- Players with a C or below are required to complete the grade form and deliver it to their coach for a discussion and plan. If this is not followed, the player will sit half of that week's game.
- A positive attitude is very important, I ask that you do your best and put forth the effort to achieve your personal and team goals.

General Information for the Parents:

- Your child is responsible for themselves while on the team. Please work with the coaches to help facilitate their growth as an athlete while encouraging them to be more independent in making good decisions.
- If your athlete is having an issue on the team, please have them speak to me directly. If I am unable to help, we will research other resources that can.
- At games, parents are expected to be respectful to the refs, coaches and players of an opposing team.

Team Communication:

- All team/player group communication will take place in the Team Snap chat room. The chat room is a great place to talk about what the team will wear on game day, team ribbons, carpool and other team communication.
- If players have a group text during the season there will be a team punishment. We want to make sure our players are speaking to each other in a respectful manner and that no one is left out on important team information! By utilizing the TeamSnap chat room, all players will receive every message.

Practices:

- All practices must be attended unless otherwise arranged with your coach.
 - Unexcused practices will result in not being able to compete in the following game.
 - Your coach must be contacted directly by the athlete, a parent/guardian, or teacher if the absence or tardiness is school related.
 - If a lacrosse game falls on a school day, the athlete must attend all of their classes, unless excused early to attend the game by the coaches.
 - 2 or more missed practices during the week of competition, you will not play in the following game.
 - You must attend practice the day before the game in order to compete in the game unless previously arranged with your coach.

Games:

- You MUST be at practice the day before a game in order to compete (unless previously arranged with your coach)!
- Coaches will excuse the team from school as necessary, based on the location of the game. Athletes must attend all classes the day of a game.
- Sportsmanship for our team is important. This includes our athletes, our parents and those we are competing against.

Grade Requirements:

Grade requirements to compete are as follows:

- 1 D all other C - Eligible to compete
- 2 D all other C - Not Eligible to compete
- F in any subject - Not Eligible to compete
- If you fail one or more classes at the end of the semester, your eligibility to remain on the team will be in jeopardy.
- This will be discussed on an individual basis.

Other Information:

- All players are expected to attend all team practices, games and scheduled events regardless of whether you can compete due to injury or ineligibility.
- Any athlete caught using illegal substances, alcohol and/or vaping during the season will be reported to the high school and will not be able to participate in the following three games.
- Please be mindful of pictures and comments posted on social media websites. All posts should be respectful and appropriate as you are representing Columbine Girls Lacrosse.

Uniforms:

- Uniforms are property of the Columbine High School Girls Lacrosse Booster Club. I understand that I must return the uniform at the end of the season. It is understood that if the uniform is lost or stolen resulting in failure to return the uniform, I am responsible for the replacement cost of for the whole uniform. Uniform replacement costs will be added to the player's outstanding fees incurred by the Booster Club and/or Columbine High School, if not turned in by the uniform turn in date. For seniors, failure to turn in uniforms and/or pay outstanding fees will result in the holding of your diploma until fees are paid in full.
