

## **STUDENT/PARENT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

I/participant agree it is a privilege for my child to participate in the Lake Tapps Ski & SnowBoard Club (hereafter referred to as LTSSC) Participation is purely voluntary and is not required. In consideration of permission being granted to me/participant to participate in LTSSC, I /participant agree to the following:

1. I/participant is aware that skiing and snowboarding are a hazardous sport that includes certain risks and dangers, including the risk of serious injury or death. I voluntarily accept full responsibility for all the risks involved, including risk inherent in skiing, snowboarding and the ski/mountain environment. I/participant accept responsibility to ski safety at all times, to abide by the Skier Responsibility Code, and to obey all posted behavior notices and any other ski area rules and policies. Equipment I use with skiing or snowboarding, I use at my own risk.

2. In consideration of acceptance of my enrollment in LTSSC, I on behalf of myself/participant as well as our heirs, personal representatives, guardians, successors, and assignees, hereby agree that I/participant will not sue or make claim against LTSSC or its directors, volunteers, drivers, agent contractors, subsidiaries, offers for any loss, injury or damage resulting from any cause including negligence, which arises out of my participation in or travel to and from the Crystal Mountain. I, on behalf of myself/participant as well as our heirs, personal representatives, guardians, successors, and assignees, hereby RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS and INDEMNIFY LTSSC, including its directors, officers, volunteers, and sponsors from and against any and all civil claims, demand, losses, suits, liabilities, costs or other damages including court costs and attorney fees arising of or in connection with any damage to their parties occasioned by, incident to, arising out of, or in connection with participation.

3. I have read and understand this Agreement is a release of legal rights and claims, and am fully competent to sign this Agreement, and that I execute this Agreement for full, adequate, and complete consideration fully intending for myself and for the participants family, estate, heirs, administrators, personal representatives, or assigns to be bound by the same. I, the undersigned (or parent/guardian, if participant is under 18 years old), understand that this is a legally binding agreement and release of liability of LTSSC. I agree to HOLD HARMLESS and INDEMNIFY LTSSC for any claims brought to me by the minor. I accept full responsibility for all medical expenses incurred as a result of the minor's participation in LTSSC.

## Rules for students of Lake Tapps Ski/Snowboard Club Participants

My child and I agree that it is a privilege for to participate in Lake Tapps Ski/Snowboard Club. The following procedures are set forth for the safety of all participants and apply for the duration of the program. **Compliance with these rules is mandatory for each ski/snowboard school participant.** Students who violate any of the rules or pose a discipline problem will face disciplinary action. The level of discipline may include forfeiting participation without refund in the program for one day up to total expulsion from the program depending on the severity of the violation. Students will assume responsibility to ski/snowboard safely at all times, abide by the 'skier responsibility code' and obey all posted behavior notices, snow conditions and other ski/snowboard ski area rules and policies.

1. All students are required to be enrolled and attending classes at DSD on the day of ski school
2. No controlled substances are allowed – this includes drugs, alcohol or tobacco of any form
3. No weapons
4. No fighting
5. No stealing
6. No profanity or vulgarity
7. No viewing/listening to inappropriate material on electronic devices
8. Be respectful to Crystal Mtn. employees, program volunteers and fellow students
9. No skiing/snowboarding in out of bounds or marked areas
10. No skiing/snowboarding at night in non-lighted areas
11. No throwing snow or snowballs
12. No building of jumps
13. No unauthorized jumping off any of Crystal Mountain resort maintained jumps without supervision by Crystal Mountain Ski Patrol or Ski School Instructors
14. All students will use the ski buddy rule (No skiing alone)
15. All students will be prepared for all weather conditions (Chaperones will watch for students not dressed properly for inclement weather – sweatshirts will not be permitted)
16. Purchasing of unauthorized items at Crystal Mountain Grocery Store is not allowed
17. All students are required to attend ski/snowboard classes or otherwise be accounted for
18. Any student found loitering in the lodge will be asked if something is wrong, otherwise the student needs to be out on the slopes
19. Any required medication must be accompanied by a doctor's note and must be kept at the Ski School Table under supervision of a Chaperone
20. No unauthorized transportation to or away from the mountain
21. Skis, boards and poles are not allowed in the lodge or entryway and must be stowed in designated areas (except those having lockers in the Brown Bag level)
22. The lodge elevator is for handicapped and staff use only
