Discussion Items for the August 10, 2023 Meeting

1. DISCUSSION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Scott leads the discussion.

The metal strain poles and pedestals heads can be powder coated black.
The cost of that is approximately \$8,000 per intersection using Powell Bill funds.

MOTION: TO APPROVE THE BETTERMENT COSTS FOR POWDER COATED BLACK POLES & PEDESTALS AT THE 66/DARROW ROAD & 66/MAIN STREET INTERSECTIONS AT A COST OF \$8K PER INTERSECTION

Cost sharing with DOT for sidewalks on the Old Hollow Road project will be an 80/20 split using Powell Bill funds.

8319 square yards @ \$50/sq. yd. = \$415,950.

Walkertown's 20% = \$83,190.00

This brings the **Municipal Agreement to \$99,190.00.**

Council is in agreement to request NCDOT add a connector sidewalk at 66/CVS to existing sidewalk using Powell Bill funds with an 80/20 split with DOT.

2. PROJECT UPDATES

Council is in agreement to have Scott purchase 20 - 4 foot double Christmas Wreaths to be placed on Main Street & Harley Drive.

Scott leads a discussion on fire service.

Peggy: The Council of Governments received 2.4 million dollars in ARPA grants.
