“The Scio Township Board of Trustees determined that it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Township and its residents to raise funds to provide for...public transportation services.” Improved public transportation services can provide freedom for residents to get to jobs, doctors’ appointments, shopping, religious services and to visit family and friends. The proposed services will also help steer development to urban areas, preserving farmland and open spaces.

Scio Township Transportation Millage Proposal Language

“Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property on the Township of Scio, County of Washtenaw, Michigan, be increased by 0.3627 mil (\$0.3627 per thousand dollars of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2015 to 2024, inclusive, for the propose of providing funds for public transportation services in Scio Township. It is estimated that 0.3627 mil would raise approximately \$403,000 when first levied”.

The cost to the average property owner is approximately \$45/year.¹

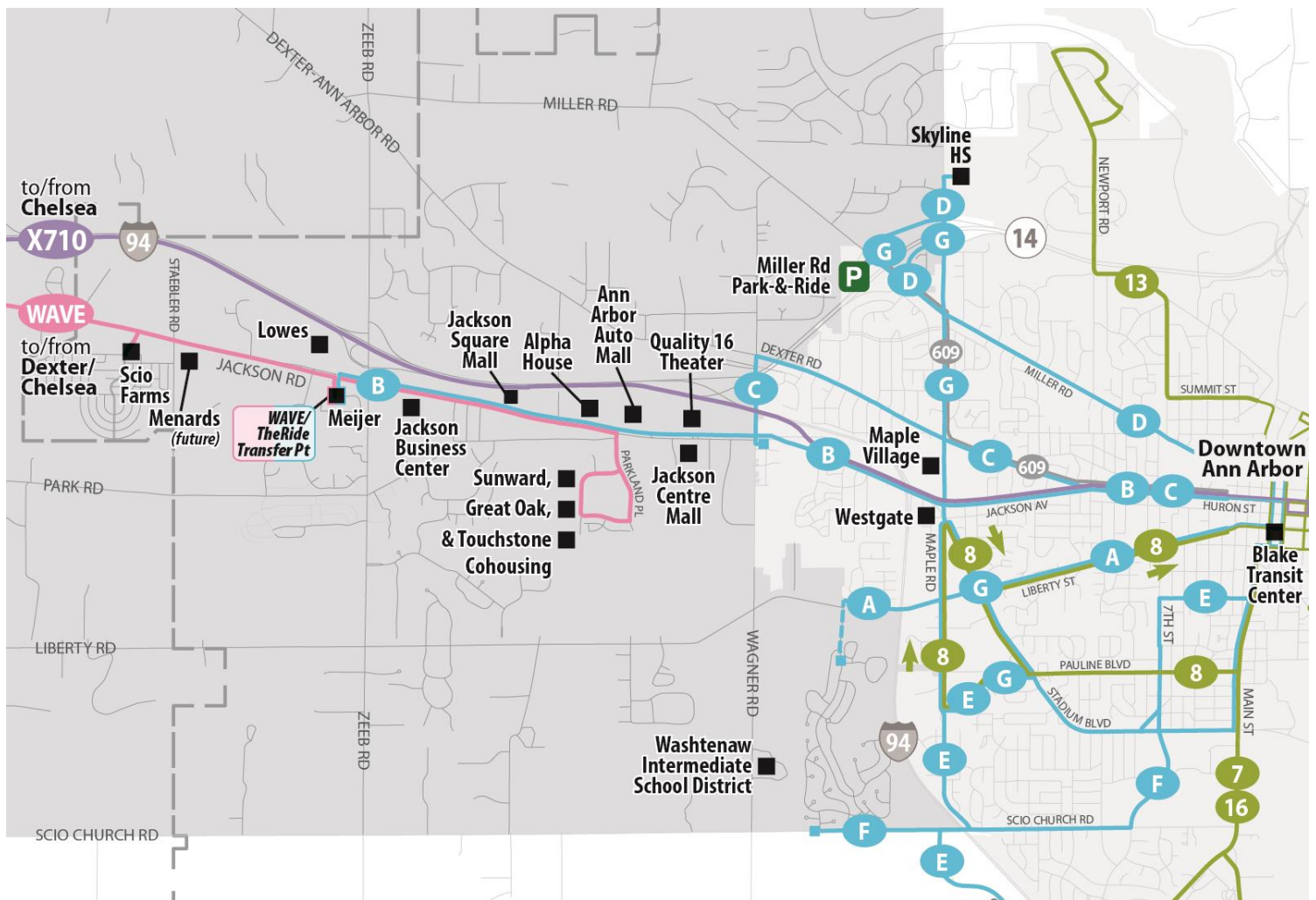
PHASE 1 – Service to begin May 1, 2016

- Dial-A-Ride services for seniors and people with disabilities to provide more freedom to get to medical appointments, jobs, shopping, and religious services and to visit family and friends.
- Three bus routes serving businesses and residential areas in Scio Township providing connections to jobs, shopping, schools, restaurants and Downtown Ann Arbor.
 - **Route 26 Scio Church** (*Map Route F*)
 - Service every 30 minutes weekdays and 60 minutes weekday evenings and weekends
 - Monday – Friday Hours: 6:30 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.
 - Saturday Hours: 7:45 a.m. – 10:00 p.m., Sunday Hours: 9:15 a.m – 6:42 p.m.
 - Connects to Pioneer High School, Ice Cube, Downtown Ann Arbor
 - **Route 29-Liberty-Scio Ridge** (*Map Route A*)
 - Service every 30 minutes weekdays and 60 minutes weekday evenings and weekends
 - Monday – Friday Hours: 6:30 a.m. – 11:15 p.m.
 - Saturday Hours: 7:45 a.m. – 10:15 p.m. Sunday Hours: 8:45 a.m. – 7:15 p.m.
 - Connects neighborhoods to jobs, schools, shopping and Downtown Ann Arbor
 - **Route 30-Jackson-Zeeb** (*Map Route B*)
 - Service every 30 minutes weekdays and 60 minutes weekday evenings and weekends
 - Monday – Friday Hours: 6:45 a.m. – 11:30 p.m.
 - Saturday Hours: 7:45 a.m. – 11:30 p.m. Sunday Hours: 8:45 a.m. – 7:30 p.m.
 - Connects to jobs, shopping, restaurants and Downtown Ann Arbor
 - Connections to WAVE transit services along Jackson Rd. including Meijer

PHASE 2 – 2017 (Service date dependent on timing of new bus delivery)

- Expanded Service on Jackson Rd. from Zeeb Rd. to Baker Rd.
 - Monday – Friday
 - Hours of service to be established prior to implementation
