

The March 9, 2021 meeting of St. Albans Township was called to order by Chairman, Randal Almendinger.

All trustees and fiscal officer were present.

The minutes of the February meeting were read and approved as read.

The fiscal officer read fund balances to date.

Chad Brown Director of the Licking County Health Dept. talked about COVID vaccines, clinics and upcoming clinics.

Larry Kretzman, a representative from Southwest Licking Water and Sewer, spoke to trustees and said they are ready to sit down and talk if trustees are ready.

Harold Lee said he is having issues keeping water in his pond.

Tom Frederick gave the February zoning report.

Tom and trustee briefly discussed making regulations on flag lots in the township.

Mike Theisen gave the February Fire and EMS reports.

Mike said the printers that he got approval on at last months meeting didn't have document feeders so he would like approval to increase the amount for the new quote he received.

Bruce Lane made a motion to approve the increased cost of printers by \$675.00 from the February meeting.

Mike said the garage doors are scheduled for installation this week and the bay floors are scheduled for April.

David Lees asked Mike questions about fire department issues such as garage doors being left open when its cold out, outside lights being burned out and not replaced and floors not looking clean.

Mike responded he would put a memo out to make sure garage doors are shut when it's cold outside to keep the heat in the building, there are issues with the lights outside and an electrician needs to look at them, of which Mike called when he was made aware of, and the floors are cared for as time permits.

Bruce Lane said the electrician will be at the new township building on Wednesday, and Bruce has all other issues mitigated at this time.

Jean Morrison mentioned bringing township records from the current township building to the room available at the fire station for storage so they are better organized. Bruce Lane said there will be plenty of room at the new township building for us to keep them there.

Randal Almendinger made a motion to appoint Warren Young and Anita McCoy as alternates to the BZA.

Trustees had a couple calls from residents saying they are being charged \$3.00 for a paper statement from Waste Away.

Randal Almendinger said he spoke to the rep from Waste Away and said our residents are not receiving this charge because we are under contract with them.

The fiscal Officer presented the 2021 mowing proposal from T3's Lawn Service. Price is the same as previous year being \$3000.00 for the cemeteries and \$1100.00 for Fireman's park.

Randal Almendinger made a motion to accept T3's lawn proposal for 2021 at a total cost of \$4100.00 for the cemeteries and Fireman's Park.
