NPUnited Travel Soccer 11U-12U





NPUnited has entered into a strategic partnership with another area club, USF Real, to base 11U and 12U travel soccer teams in New Palestine, Indiana. Our teams practice and play home games in New Palestine under the USF Real banner. We play similar aged teams from clubs in Indiana participating in the Indiana Soccer League (ISL). The amount of travel is dependent on the division the team registers in and at this age group we will try to register in a division that limits travel to central Indiana.

Practice: 2 nights per week with team's coach and technical training 1 night every other week.

<u>Games</u>: 8-10 regular season games, plus a weekend tournament, and a couple "friendly" practice games scheduled by the coach. ISL limits game day roster size to 16 players (11-12U).

<u>Coaches</u>: USF Real normally requires travel coaches be certified with the State "E" license or higher to provide the highest level of training to your child and all must pass a thorough background check for your child's safety.

<u>Cost</u>: Fees cover team and player registrations with ISL, referee fees, tournament registrations, technical training and winter sessions.

- Several billing options are available
- Uniforms: Uniforms are not included in the price of registration. Please see attached information regarding uniform information.

Choose the hyperlink "Webstore" under the USF Real Indiana name at the top of the page.

There are two tabs from which to choose to order uniforms:

- Mandatory Player Kits-Mens
- Mandatory Player Kits-Womens

You will see the two required uniform kits and one required jersey:

- The USF Real Kit
- The Penske Chevy Kit
- The Penske Honda Jersey

You will choose your team name from the drop-down menu, and then you will choose the player name. Your uniform number has been provided by the club, and it will automatically be entered for your order.

Select the sizes you need for each kit and for the Honda jersey. There is an online "fitting room" that will allow you to input your measurements. Your size will be recommended based on your measurements.

There are other optional items you may order at this time as well, from the tabs labelled Warm-ups and Training. These are optional items and are not required by the club.

When you are ready, choose "checkout".

What are our Overall Objectives?

- o Focus on development of the players
- Instill lasting technical skills and introduce tactics
- Utilize small sided play (11-12U) to expand creativity, ball mastery & field awareness; challenging players to play more "creatively" & "instinctively", with & without the ball

What if my child can only play in the Fall or Spring?

- The league has taken this into consideration and while you are registered for a full year (per ISL rules), you only pay for the season in which your child plays.
- Due to league roster limitations we will need to consider the commitment to ensure that full teams can be fielded for both seasons
- Winter training is included with any commitment to play
- See fee schedule for details

Is my child ready for travel soccer?

- Players will be receiving advanced technical training and need to be physically able to perform tasks and have the ability to comprehend given instructions.
- Our goal is to develop player's skills in a positive and fun environment, disruptive and disrespectful behavior toward anyone at the soccer fields will not be tolerated.

What do we expect from the players?

- Players are expected to participate with a positive attitude.
- Players are expected to respect the coaches by listening when they are talking, by doing what is asked of you and by working hard.
- Players are expected to respect their teammates and opponents, displaying good sportsmanship at all times.

What can you expect from the coaches?

- o Patient communicate in a way so that all players understand what is expected
- o Positive instruct and encourage players to do their personal best
- Knowledgeable obtain a minimum E license and promote the clubs development goals
- Have an open door policy for the parents create a positive experience for everyone

What do we expect from the parents?

- o Cheer for your child & their teammates
- Support your child by encouraging them to listen to their coaches
- o Don't interrupt practice or games, coach from the sideline or talk negatively about the referee, other players, parents or coaches, etc.

What is winter training?

 The league rents a local facility for indoor practice over the winter months to keep the players active. Attendance is not mandatory, but is recommended.
