In accordance with the STATE GUIDELINES the following is Heritage Children's Academy's sick policy:

Child care rule 0804

Infectious and Contagious Disease Control

If symptoms indicating a child is becoming ill begin while the child is in care, or the condition changes after arriving at the center, the child must be separated from the other children and the parent will be notified of the child's condition.

Children must be excluded from care until a full 24 hours *after* the SYMPTOMS subside if they have any of the following illnesses.

- Temperature over 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher underarm/auxiliary
- Strep Throat
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Chicken Pox
- Flu
- *Other less common illnesses if the state requires children to be excluded (parents will be notified by management if exclusion is required).

Children will be sent home and must *receive treatment* for the following conditions (children can return the day after treatment is started):

- Impetigo (cover until crusted over in healing)
- Ringworm (cover until crusted over in healing)
- Scabies (cover until crusted over in healing)
- Lice

**We reserve the right to send any child home if they are unable to function successfully in the childcare setting in accordance with the state. If your child exhibits any of the above symptoms *they may not return for any reason before the 24 hours*. Since we are unable to determine when a child gets sick (vomit, diarrhea, fever) we must follow the state guidelines by adhering to this policy. These guidelines have been set forth for the safety and well-being of all children.
