General Information

Share what your organization has accomplished over the last year with an educational exhibit. Exhibits are to be entered in the Sheep Barn (with livestock registration). Exhibits will be displayed in former Vegetable Barn or may be placed in the gym if space in the former Vegetable Barn does not allow. Exhibits should be no wider than the size of a standard tri-board poster (48 inches). Additional props (flyers, handouts, examples of project work, giveaways etc.) are welcome as part of the exhibit as long as they are contained within the size limits. Exhibits should be informational; observers should learn something from your display. Exhibits judged on the Danish System of Blue, Red and White awards. Can be more than one blue award per category. A Judges Choice Poster may be chosen from all four categories, which includes additional prize money.

Class:

1. Educational Exhibits by 4-H or FFA sponsored Youth Organizations in Highland County (4-H Community Clubs, In-School 4-H, 4-H Enrichment, 4-H Camping, FFA Chapters, FFA Contests/Winners etc.)
2. Educational Exhibits by non-4-H/FFA sponsored Youth Organizations in Highland County (Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Radio Club, Youth Philanthropy Council, etc.)
3. Educational Exhibits by Churches and Church Groups in Highland County (outreach, youth groups, church mission, food pantries, vacation bible school, etc.)
4. Educational Exhibits by any other club, school class, or organization in Highland County (Homemakers, Quilt Guild, Class of 2021, vocational class projects, science fair/demo, etc.)
