THEME: “**DARKNESS!**” This can cover anything from nightscapes, to dark moods, to dark subject matter, dark abstracts, etc. We will need 80+ pieces for the main gallery. In keeping with the theme, please WEAR ALL BLACK CLOTHING! And your NAME TAG. This will make us easy to find.

OPENING/RECEPTION: We will bring our own refreshments. Reply to Audrey Dulmes at [atdulmes@gmail.com](mailto:atdulmes@gmail.com) with what you are bringing. Laura Easey-Jones will be putting together a playlist of appropriate music. (Thank you, Laura!)

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any Rogues Artists Group member. Painting, sculpture, artist's books, ceramics, video, assemblage, photography, metalwork, jewelry, etchings, collage, and fibers are all welcome. No crafts!

AWARDS: **This will be a juried exhibition with ribbons and cash awards.** Places are BOS, first, second, third and 2 honorable mentions. Cash awards: BOS - \$150.00, 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$100.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$75.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$50.00, 2 Honorables at \$25.00 each. Something new!! – We have 6 blue BOS ribbons left from a mistake at the printer. Our BOS ribbons are now purple. **We are going to give a blue BOS ribbon award for “People’s Choice.” Awards ceremony details TBD.**

COPYRIGHT: All art must be original. Compositions from published material, other artists’ work, photographs not taken by the artist, and gicleés of any kind are not considered original works. Each Artist warrants and represents their artwork is original, that they created the artwork and possess the

unencumbered title and copyright to each work exhibited under this agreement. The Gallery shall take all reasonable steps to assure the Artists' copyrights for artwork is protected. Exhibition of an artwork constitutes the agreement to all conditions listed in this prospectus.

**DELIVERY:** Packing materials cannot be stored by the gallery. You must take it with you at drop off.

**DISPLAY:** Hanging system: screws on concrete or hooks on Propanels. All work must **conform to professional standards.**

- 2-D pieces must be properly wired to D-rings or screw eyes, framed and ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers. Size limit: 48 x 36. You have to be able to get it up the stairs to the Attic. Please do not bring tiny pieces or work valued under \$400.00
- 2-D Work on paper should be covered with glass or acrylic. White or off-white mats are preferred for watercolors and other works on paper. Deckle-edge works may be floated, framed and glazed.
- Gallery -wrapped canvases must have the edges painted with the image extending over the edge or the edges must be painted a color or black. No studio-wraps with stapled edges unless they are framed.
- Artwork cannot be substituted or withdrawn from the Exhibition after the opening date.
- Use of impermanent materials like puffy glue or glitter will not be accepted. Please use permanent materials whenever possible.
- For 3-D work, the gallery has 3 pedestals available on a first dibs basis. If they are gone by the time you submit your request, you will have to bring your own pedestal.
- Required: Please attach label with name, title, medium, and size to back or bottom of each submission. **No pricing, no contact info please.**
- Artwork exhibited must be **appropriate for viewing** by all ages of the general public. Artwork that is overtly sexual, racist, violent, libelous, slanderous, demoralizing or discriminatory in nature is strictly prohibited.

**SALES:** The Rogues members are required to offer their art for sale. David Barnett Gallery charges a 50% commission on all work. **You may choose to agree to a negotiating discount of 10% or 20% that comes off the posted retail price. (this nets 5-10% off your portion)** **Make sure your pricing takes that into account. Please do not bring tiny pieces or work valued under \$400.00.**

## ENTRY PROCESS & DEADLINE:

1. **Deadline for all entries is Midnight, October 1st, 2024.**
2. Complete the online application form located on The Rogues website, [www.roguesartists.org](http://www.roguesartists.org). **Click the Rogues logo to access the form.** The instructions are listed on the top of the form. **Please use one form per submission.**
3. Upload images for jurying and publicity by clicking the link beneath the form or send by email to [rogue1gallery@gmail.com](mailto:rogue1gallery@gmail.com). Images are to be sized to 10" x 10" (3000 x 3000 pixels) maximum height or width, or 300 ppi. Label your image files as follows: YOUR\_NAME\_TITLE\_SIZE\_MEDIUM\_PRICE.
4. Those whose work is juried in will receive a consignment form. The consignment form will also be posted on the Events page for downloading when you lose it. Fill it out and bring it with you to the drop off.
