Rev. Joe Robinson has been a fixture in the community in and around Titusville for decades. Rev. Robinson has been the Executive Director of North Brevard Charities Sharing Center for the last 18 years. Rev. Robinson has proudly helped in the supervision and creation of housing initiatives for homeless and needy families for emergency, short term and long term situations. He has also served as the Associate Minister at Antioch Christian Fellowship where he is the Minister of Bible Study as well as a Sunday school teacher.

When Rev. Robinson first came to Brevard, he offered his talents by holding the position of Vice President and Director of Operations for the Brevard Workforce Development for 2 years where he managed and supervised all activities relating to administration of the Operations Department.

Before coming to Brevard County, Rev. Robinson spent 24 years in the United States Coast Guard as an Engineer Officer where he supervised and trained engineering and law enforcement activities. He also provided training programs and guidance to undergraduate engineers in technical application and personnel management for naval engineering certification. Additionally, he was a training officer for multi-national and multi-service engineering training programs for the Caribbean Nations' military drug defense readiness and helped to establish an engineering school for Haitian Naval personnel for the State Department.

Rev. Robinson received a degree in Business Management and Psychology and has advanced studies in Government Procurement, Contracting, Naval Engineering and System Design. He has been a member of numerous organizations including Links of Hope for 13 years and President of the Board for 6 years; past President of the Titusville Rotary, Chairman of Cities of Cocoa and Titusville Affordable Housing Committees; as well as a Board member of Aging Matters, the Alliance for Neighborhood Restoration for Brevard County and the Community Housing Initiative for Brevard County.
