

Prov 1:1 The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel;

Prov 1:2 To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;

Prov 1:3 To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;

Prov 19:20 Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.

Prov 1:4 To give subtilty to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion.

Prov 1:5 A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels:

Prov 9:9 Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

Matt 13:12 **For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath.**

Prov 1:6 To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings.

Prov 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Prov 1:8 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

Prov 4:1 Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding.

Prov 6:20 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

Prov 1:9 For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

Prov 1:10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.

Prov 1:11 If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk privily for the innocent without cause:

Jer 5:26 For among my people are found wicked men: they lay wait, as he that setteth snares; they set a trap, they catch men.

Hab 1:5 Behold ye among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvellously: for I will work a work in your days, which ye will not believe, though it be told you.

Prov 1:12 Let us swallow them up alive as the grave; and whole, as those that go down into the pit:

Prov 1:13 We shall find all precious substance, we shall fill our houses with spoil:

Prov 1:14 Cast in thy lot among us; let us all have one purse:

Prov 1:15 My son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path:

Psa 119:101 I have refrained my feet from every evil way, that I might keep thy word.

Prov 1:16 For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood.

Prov 1:17 Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird.

Prov 1:18 And they lay wait for their own blood; they lurk privily for their own lives.

Prov 11:19 As righteousness tendeth to life: so he that pursueth evil pursueth it to his own death.

Prov 1:19 So are the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; which taketh away the life of the owners thereof.

1Tim 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Prov 1:20 Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets:

John 7:37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.**

Lev 23:36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.

Prov 1:21 She crieth in the chief place of concourse, in the openings of the gates: in the city she uttereth her words, saying,

Prov 1:22 How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge?

Prov 1:23 Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

Acts 17:21 (For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing.)

Prov 1:24 Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded;

Isa 66:4 I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and chose that in which I delighted not.

Jer 7:13 And now, because ye have done all these works, saith the LORD, and I spake unto you, rising up early and speaking, but ye heard not; and I called you, but ye answered not;

2Chr 36:15 And the LORD God of their fathers sent to them by his messengers, rising up betimes, and sending; because he had compassion on his people, and on his dwelling place:

Jer 25:3 From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, even unto this day, that is the three and twentieth year, the word of the LORD hath come unto me, and I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye have not hearkened.

Jer 11:7 For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day that I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, even unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, Obey my voice.

Jer 35:15 I have sent also unto you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, saying, Return ye now every man from his evil way, and amend your doings, and go not after other gods to serve them, and ye shall dwell in the land which I have given to you and to your fathers: but ye have not inclined your ear, nor hearkened unto me.

Jer 29:19 Because they have not hearkened to my words, saith the LORD, which I sent unto them by my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them; but ye would not hear, saith the LORD.

Jer 18:11 Now therefore go to, speak to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I frame evil against you, and devise a device against you: return ye now everyone from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good.

2Kgs 17:13 Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments and my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

Jer 11:8 Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked everyone in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not.

Jer 13:10 This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to worship them, shall even be as this girdle, which is good for nothing.

Jer 16:12 And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:

Jer 7:26 Yet they hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse than their fathers.

Prov 1:25 But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof:

Prov 1:26 I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh;

Ps 2:4 He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision. [Ps. 37:13]

Ps 37:13 The Lord shall laugh at him: for he seeth that his day is coming.

Ps 59:8 But thou, O LORD, shalt laugh at them; thou shalt have all the heathen in derision.

1Sam 26:10 David said furthermore, As the LORD liveth, the LORD shall smite him; or his day shall come to die; or he shall descend into battle, and perish.

Luke 18:7 **And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?**

Rev 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Ps 13:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? forever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

Ps 89:46 How long, LORD? wilt thou hide thyself forever? shall thy wrath burn like fire?

Job 13:24 Wherefore hidest thou thy face, and holdest me for thine enemy?

Deut 32:20 And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith.

Lam 2:5 The Lord was as an enemy: he hath swallowed up Israel, he hath swallowed up all her palaces: he hath destroyed his strong holds, and hath increased in the daughter of Judah mourning and lamentation.

Jer 30:14 All thy lovers have forgotten thee; they seek thee not; for I have wounded thee with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of thine iniquity; because thy sins were increased.

Jer 22:3 Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

Jer 22:4 For if ye do this thing indeed, then shall there enter in by the gates of this house kings sitting upon the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, he, and his servants, and his people.

Jer 22:5 But if ye will not hear these words, I swear by myself, saith the LORD, that this house shall become a desolation.

Matt 23:38 **Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.**

Job 18:20 They that come after him shall be astonished at his day, as they that went before were affrighted.

Ps 13:2 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?

Ps 13:3 Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death;

Ps 13:4 Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

Ps 13:5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.

Ps 13:6 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.

Prov 1:27 When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.

Ps 37:9 For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

Prov 10:25 As the whirlwind passeth, so is the wicked no more: but the righteous is an everlasting foundation.

Prov 1:28 Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:

1Sam 8:18 And ye shall cry out in that day because of your king which ye shall have chosen you; and the LORD will not hear you in that day.

Isa 1:15 And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.

Mic 3:4 Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

Ps 18:41 They cried, but there was none to save them: even unto the LORD, but he answered them not.

Prov 1:29 For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD:

Prov 1:30 They would none of my counsel: they despised all my reproof.

Psa 81:11 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me.

Deut 32:15 But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered with fatness; then he forsook God which made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his salvation.

Isa 1:4 Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

Isa 51:13 And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where is the fury of the oppressor?

Isa 17:10 Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:

Job 20:7 Yet he shall perish for ever like his own dung: they which have seen him shall say, Where is he?

Jer 2:32 Can a maid forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.

Psa 106:21 They forgat God their saviour, which had done great things in Egypt;

Psa 104:2 Who coverest thyself with light as with a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain:

Psa 95:1 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.

Prov 1:31 Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices.

Prov 1:32 For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.

Prov 1:33 But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.
