Please know that if you plan on performing any type of repairs, renovations or alterations to your home or property, you may be required to obtain a building permit. You can obtain an application and pay the required fee at the Borough's office located at 1300 Brinton Road. The application will be reviewed by the Borough's building inspector.

Once you are officially a new resident of the Borough, you must contact the Borough Secretary to update all billing information (taxes, refuse, and sewage). You will need to provide the property address, your name, and preferably the previous owner's name.

If you plan to operate any type of business in the Borough, you may be subject to the Borough's Business Privilege Tax or Mercantile Tax. Please contact Jordan Tax Service to obtain the appropriate forms and information relative to these taxes.
