Items not allowed in school

We have staff and students with allergies and sensitivities that we must take into consideration. Student Illness

There are a few illnesses making the rounds in the community. Student Medications

Every year colds, flu, and other ailments make their way through the school population. <u>If your child</u> <u>must take medication during the school day, it</u> <u>must be processed through the school office.</u> Parents/Guardians are required to come in and sign medication forms. All prescription medication must be in the original bottle with the pharmacy label. Over-the-counter medications must be in the original bottle. Inhalers should have a label on the barrel. Students are NOT allowed to keep medications with them or in their lockers.
