PARENT AND SKATER AGREEMENT

In order to maintain a fun, safe environment for all participants, the following rules have been established and must be followed during all schedules Tri-State Toe Picks F.S.C. (referred to in this document as the "Club") time. Violation of these rules by skater or parent can result in suspension from the Club.

RULES:

- Skaters and Parents in Club activities are expected to be courteous and considerate.
- Respect is to be shown toward all personnel and fellow skaters.
- Keep the ice and arena clean. Follow the rules of the arena.
- All skaters must be chemical free whenever participating in Club activities.
- Skaters must check in with the rink monitor prior to skating.
- Skaters must wear appropriate skating attire. Hair is to be pulled back and secured off the face.
- No jeans or exceptionally long pants are allowed.
- No gum chewing or food on the ice.
- An adult must be in the arena prior to anyone starting to skate.
- If a skater falls or is injured, please let a coach, rink monitor or an adult assist as needed.
- Avoid nonessentials talking while on the ice; Leave the ice for visiting.
- Coaches will approve all music.
- Rink monitors and volunteers will play music in the order it is received. All skaters must receive equal time to play their music.
- ***Clear the ice immediately at the end of your skating session. Please have your personal items collected before the session is over. All skaters need to off the ice when the Zamboni is running.***

DISCIPLINE:

- Coaches and Rink Monitors have the authority to enforce and regulate rules, using verbal direction to skaters as needed.
- Participants will receive one verbal warning when violating any rule. The participant will be asked to leave the ice for the remainder of the session if a second violation occurs.

PARENTS EXPECTATIONS:

- To help keep a safe environment for all, rink monitors will be requested. Rink monitor's duties include assisting with checking skaters in for lessons, monitoring the flow and discipline of the rink, maintaining a safe skating environment and overseeing that the required documents are accessible for emergencies. Such documents contain skater's medical releases.
- Keep up to date on information. Read notes sent home with the skaters, check website and openly talk to board members and coaches.
- Questions regarding competitions or technical questions regarding skating should be directed to the skater's coach. These questions should be addressed well in advance of skating time or post skating time. Due to our precious ice time, do not keep the coaching staff off the ice during lesson time.
- Contact a board member if you have any questions, comments, and/or concerns.
- If a skater taking private lessons switches coaches for any reason, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to give notification to the coach and make sure that all bills are paid. The Club is not responsible for any private lesson fees, competition costs, unpaid coach fees or any costs associated with private lessons.

SAFESPORT STATEMENT FOR MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Tri-State Toe Picks FSC is committed to creating a safe and positive environment for members' physical, emotional and social development and ensuring that it promotes an environment free of misconduct.

The following code of conduct applies to all participants in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, The Tri-State Toe Picks FSC, and the Onalaska Omni Center including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions, training camps and local rink activities.

I recognize that my participation or my child's in all the activities associated with U.S. Figure Skating and The Tri-State Toe Picks FSC is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents.

U.S. FIGURE SKATING MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT GR 1.02

I recognize that my participation in all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions and training camps, is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents. As a precondition to participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I will adhere to the following tenets in good faith:

A. I will exhibit the highest standards of fairness, ethical behavior and genuine good sportsmanship in all of my relations with others.

B. I will not damage public or private property. I understand that I may be held financially responsible for damage deemed to be wantonly or willfully executed on my part, and that I may be subject to disciplinary action by U.S. Figure Skating.

C. I will not use or possess illegal drugs, and I will not engage in criminal activity. I understand that, if I am found to use or possess illegal drugs, or if I am found to engage in any criminal activity during any activity hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I may be subject to criminal penalties as well as penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating.

D. I will adhere to the rules of U.S. Figure Skating and the host organization at all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

E. I will comply with all applicable anti-doping rules including, but not limited to, ISU and USADA anti-doping rules.

F. I will conduct myself in a manner not detrimental to the welfare of figure skating. I understand that my actions reflect on U.S. Figure Skating and the sport of figure skating both positively and negatively. I understand that if my acts, statements, or conduct are considered detrimental to the welfare of figure skating by the appropriate authority, I may be subject to penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating pursuant to GR 1.04.

G. I understand that the penalties that may be imposed may include, but are not limited to, loss of future international selections, loss of financial support from U.S. Figure Skating and its Memorial Fund, and loss of participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

H. I understand that all disciplinary proceedings will be conducted pursuant to Article XXV, Section 3, of the U.S. Figure Skating bylaws, and that my rights and remedies are derived therefrom.

TRI-STATE TOE PICKS' EXPECTATIONS OF ICE SESSIONS

OFF ICE EXPECTATIONS INCLUDING BEFORE AND AFTER SESSION

- Sign in and pay for each session before stepping on to the ice.
- Pick up all belongings (including dirty tissues, music, bottles, etc.) at the end of the session.
- Exit the ice promptly at the end of your session.

GENERAL ON ICE EXPECTATIONS

- Respect and show good manners to all skaters (excuse me, sorry, etc.).
- Keep your head up at all times, watch for others and observe the right of way.
 - Skater who is already in a spin.
 - Skater has started the entry to a jump (watch the jump harness area).
 - Skating doing his/her program (should be wearing belt/vest).
 - Skater who is currently in lesson.
- Follow and try to recognize common ice patterns (jumps, spins, and moves).
 - Spin in the middle of the ice between blue lines.
 - Jump at ends of the ice (not between blue lines).
 - Moves patterns can be long axis, short axis, serpentine, circular, or diagonal.
- Refrain from talking on the ice. If you need to talk, please exit the ice.
- Do not interrupt another skater's lesson.
- Do not stand in the middle of the ice or in jump corners.
- Only water is allowed on the ice. No food, gum, or colored beverages allowed on the ice.
- Hair should be secured and pulled back when skating.
- Sitting or lying on the ice is not permitted.

MUSIC & SKATING PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

- Music will be played on a rotational basis. After your program has been played, it can be placed back at the end of the line.
- It is required to wear the belt/vest when skating your program.
- Please be ready when your music starts. If there is a line, your music will not be restarted.
- On busy sessions, not everyone will have the chance to have their program music played. If you have more than one program, you can skate a second program if there is time. Turn in your music at beginning of session, if you want to practice it.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

These actions violate our Safe Sport Policy and Code of Conduct and will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the session and/or rink if these behaviors are observed.

- Any signs of aggression: kicking, scraping, digging holes, stomping.
- Verbal abuse directed at skaters, coaches, or club volunteers.
- Deliberately challenging, scaring, or intentional blocking of another skater.
- Videotaping, recording, or taking any other skater without their permission on the ice.
- Using cell phones or other recording devices in the locker rooms or bathrooms.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”)

In consideration of participating in Tri-State Toe Picks FSC activities, I represent that I understand the nature of figure skating activities (“activity”) and that I am qualified, in good health and in proper physical condition to participate in such “activity”. I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the “activity”.

I fully understand that this “activity” involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the “activity”, the conditions in which the “activity” takes place, or the negligence of the “releasees” named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the “activity”.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue The Tri-State Toe Picks FSC or United States Figure Skating, it’s directors, officers, administrators, sponsors, volunteers, agents, employees, staff, instructors, trainers, other participants and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the “activity” takes place (each considered one of the “releasees” herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the “releasees” or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.

The Tri-State Toe Picks FSC has the right, but not the obligation, to provide rules, regulations and/or ice monitors for Club Ice. We hereby acknowledge that the Tri-State Toe Picks FSC shall not be responsible for the supervision of the members at Club Ice.
