Votive Mass of Our Lady of Fatima

Our Lady of Fatima refers to the Marian apparitions that were witnessed by three shepherd children at the Cova da Iria in Fatima, Portugal. Mary appeared six times between May 13 and October 13, 1917 to Lucia dos Santos, 9, and her cousins, Francisco, 8, and Jacinta Marto, 6.

Nuestra Señora de Fátima se refiere a las apariciones marianas que fueron presenciadas por tres niños pastores en la Cova da Iria en Fátima, Portugal. Mary apareció seis veces entre el 13 de mayo y el 13 de octubre de 1917 a Lucía dos Santos, de 9 años, y sus primas, Francisco, de 8, Jacinta Marto, de 6.

On May 13, 1917, an apparition of "a woman all in white, more brilliant than the sun" presented itself to the three children wearing a white mantle edged with gold and who held a rosary in her hand. The woman asked them to pray and devote themselves to the Holy Trinity and to "say the Rosary every day" for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia. In the last apparition, on October 13, the woman revealed her name in response to Lucia's question: "I am the Lady of the Rosary." That same day, 70,000 people turned out to witness the apparition, following a promise by the woman that she would show the people that the apparitions were true. They saw the sun make three circles and move around the sky in an incredible zigzag movement in the manner which left no doubt in their minds about the veracity of the apparitions.

El 13 de mayo de 1917, una aparición de "una mujer toda de blanco, más brillante que el sol" se presentó a los tres niños con un manto blanco bordeado de oro y que sostenían un rosario en la mano. La mujer les pidió que oraran y se dedicaran a la Santísima Trinidad y que "dijeran el Rosario todos los días" por la paz mundial, por el final de la Primera Guerra Mundial, por los pecadores y por la conversión de Rusia. En la última aparición, el 13 de octubre, la mujer reveló su nombre en respuesta a la pregunta de Lucía: "Yo soy la Señora del Rosario". Ese mismo día, 70.000 personas resultaron ser testigos de la aparición, siguiendo la promesa de la mujer de que mostraría a la gente que las apariciones eran verdaderas. Vieron al sol hacer tres círculos y moverse alrededor del cielo en un increíble movimiento en zigzag de la manera que no dejó ninguna duda en sus mentes sobre la veracidad de las apariciones.

The message Our Lady imparted during the apparitions to the children concerned the violent trials that would afflict the world by means of war, starvation, and the persecution of the Church and the Holy Father in the twentieth century if the world did not make reparation for sins. She exhorted the Church to pray and offer sacrifices to God in order that peace may come upon the world, and that the trials may be averted. Mary also gave the children three secrets. The first concerned devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and the second was a vision of hell. The third secret was revealed in 2000, and spoke of a "bishop in white" who was shot by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows into him. Many people linked this vision to the assassination attempt against Pope John Paul II in St. Peter's Square on May 13, 1981.

El mensaje que la Virgen impartió durante las apariciones a los niños se refería a las pruebas violentas que afligían al mundo por medio de la guerra, el hambre y la persecución de la Iglesia y del Santo Padre en el siglo XX si el mundo no hacía reparación por pecados. Exhortó a la Iglesia a orar y ofrecer sacrificios a Dios para que la paz llegara sobre el mundo, y para que las pruebas se evitaran. María también les dio a los niños tres secretos. El primero se refería a la devoción al Corazón Inmaculado de María, y el segundo era una visión del infierno. El tercer secreto fue revelado en 2000, y habló de un "obispo de blanco" que fue disparado ser un grupo de soldados que le dispararon balas y flechas. Muchas personas vincularon esta visión con el intento de asesinato de nuevo el Papa Juan Pablo II en la Plaza de San Pedro el 13 de mayo de 1981.
