Family Conversations

Eye Spark

Look for the unexpected (like fire in a bush that does not burn).



Ear Spark

Listen for God's voice in the mouths of others, in the sounds of nature, or in music.

LIVE IT

For families to do together

Light a fire together—it could be as small as a candle or as large as a bonfire. Take turns repeating God's words to Moses.

For younger kids

Pretend you are Moses and Aaron. Practice standing tall in front of the mirror and saying in a firm voice, "Let my people go!"

For older kids

Research the work roles of children during the early years of the Industrial Revolution. What can you discover about children, school and work?
