Susan Kanoff, Arlene Davidson, and Janet Chaikin at the Symposium of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Human Trafficking Task Force. Melissa McKinley, our District Commissioner, even mentioned the original symposium, which originated through the efforts of our NCJW section.

We have had two exciting trafficking activities this past month:

- 1. Richard Davidson spoke to the Current Events Club at the Grove in Boynto Beach. This group grew out of their Democratic Club of their community and meets weekly. They chose Modern Day Slavery as their topic for the week, and Richard, after providing some updated info, guided their discussion. It was very well received. Does anyone know of a Current Events Club looking for a discussion leader? We could do this in places where we have already sent a Human Trafficking speaker. Call me if you know of any group who might be interested.
- 2. We have a new meet-up location which is perfect for the needs of our group of 30+ outreachers! The Spanish River Church on Yamato Road is convenient, large, has lots of available parking and is very centrally located.

One of the desk clerks at a hotel we recently visited recognized one of the kids whose picture we provided! The police were notified. The next outreach will be on Saturday, August 10th. Please join us if you have been trained. If not, let me know, and I'll arrange for a training session for you.

The next day Laurie Tamber, Ilene Lark Teitler and I met with State Senator Lori Berman (D) in Boynton Beach. She is a member of our NCJW section and very familiar with our work. Both meetings were very productive.

Rep. Caruso now knows who we are and what we do. Lori Berman would love our support on legislation she is currently working on to make sure that school drinking water is lead free and to establish an "orange alert" for missing individuals with autism, similar to the amber alert.

We left teen trafficking posters with both legislators, who were appreciative and interested in hearing about the many programs we are involved in. We will be meeting with Rep. Tina Scott Polsky (D) on August 22nd.

It's all eyes on the U.S. Senate to protect access to birth control and other reproductive health care by passing the Title X protection. That means we have to keep calling — again and again — until they get the message.

The Title X gag rule is unethical, dangerous, and illegal. It puts access to birth control, cancer screenings, and other reproductive health care at risk for 4 million people. It mirrors the global gag rule, which violates human rights and is causing communities around the world to lose access to vital

health information and services, including birth control, HIV prevention and treatment, and maternal health care.

Call <u>1-202-601-3441</u> to be patched through to your Senator's DC office -- demand you Senator protect access to birth control and Title X and reject all gag rules.
