

How to Join the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Composite Squadron for Prospective Senior Members

We are so happy that you have decided to join B-CC Composite Squadron! Civil Air Patrol has so many amazing opportunities for cadets, and we are glad you have chosen to take advantage of them!

In order to submit an application to become a senior member, you should first attend 3 squadron meetings to get oriented to CAP and our squadron. On your third meeting, our squadron commander will sign off on your application. After that, you will receive your CAPID number and our Deputy Commander for Seniors will guide you through your first steps as a senior member in CAP.

Here are the instructions for submitting your application

- The application is done in a paper format for senior members. It is CAPF 12, you can follow this link for the form:

 Please print it out, fill in the appropriate sections, and bring it to your third meeting for a signature by the Squadron Commander.
- 2. All senior members must undergo a background check by the FBI before an application is approved by National Headquarters. Fingerprinting can be done at our squadron for free, given that appropriate personnel are available, or you can get it done at your local police station.
- 3. National dues for senior members are \$60, and squadron dues are \$30. Please write a check for \$60 **payable to National Headquarters, Civil Air Patrol.** The \$30 squadron dues can be paid in cash or check payable to the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Composite Squadron.
- 4. Mail your application package (form, fingerprint card, check for \$60) to NHQ:
