The PADI Open Water Diver is the entry level certification course necessary to dive anywhere you are! Learning to DIVE consists of three main phases.

Knowledge Development: you can start to understand the basic principles of scuba diving today with the online program or home study. You can begin today!

Confined Water Dives: aka "pool dives," this is when the really fun part begins and you submerge to breathe underwater for the first time. Most student divers attend multiple pool sessions (up to 4 or 5) to learn the necessary skills for safe diving and to develop confidence in themselves and the instructional team.

Open Water Dives: you complete 4 dives in a lake, spring, ocean, etc. to earn your PADI Open Water Diver certification.

Prerequisites: Be 10 years or older, submit a completed medical form (available at www.padi.com or in the store) and pass the watermanship assessment (10 minute tread/float and 200 yard swim or 300 yard snorkel).

Note: Students younger than 15 earn PADI's Junior Open Water Diver certification.
