

COSMOLOGY OF CHRIST'S LIFESPAN I

SOLAR & LUNAR ECLIPSE PATTERNS IN RELATION TO CHRIST'S LIFE

The purpose of this chart is to present several points of interest that gives credence to the purported birth date of Jesus Christ as Messiah on September 11, -3 BC (-9-11). Although the date is in dispute, more so is the date of Christ's crucifixion and death. The popular notion of a 33 AD date and/or Jesus being 33 years is idealistic but not based on any real concrete facts or calculations. This study presents a possible date association solely based on astronomical patterns taken from the patterns of the lunar and solar cycles since -5 BC and the Mazzaroth pattern of the cycles of the Precession of the Equinox. Contrary to popular belief, there was no Tetrad or 4 consecutive Blood Moons from 27-34 AD. There were 4 partial solar eclipses in a row in 32 AD. There is only 1 possible eclipse that occurs on a Passover, April 14, 32 AD during this time span. There are few times in history where the Jewish and Western calendars synchronize. One such year was in 2014 where Passover occurred on the 14th of April. Perhaps such was the case in 32 AD. The full moon occurred on the 14th of April as all Passovers have to start with a full moon. What is peculiar about this full moon was that it was a Blood Moon, perhaps reminiscent of the Blood Moon that occurred the very midnight hour of the first Passover in Egypt. It was on that day that the Destroying Angel visited the land and took the First Born as was the case with Jesus Christ, as the Messiah and the 'First Born of Creation' on the altar of Calvary. The total Blood Moon occurred also in the middle of Libra, the Scales but in some ancient renditions, it was an Altar of Sacrifice. This would collaborate with the depiction of Isaac and Christ, being offered on a slab. The dual connotation though, to the Scales of Libra denote the judgment and wrath of YHVH that was placed on Christ at the Cross of Calvary that in essence was an Altar, some say perhaps the very spot in which Abraham was tried with the attempted sacrifice of Isaac. From Rosh HaShanah -3 BC of September 11 to Passover April 14, 32 AD would be the 33rd year of age of Christ as there is no '0' year in the timeline. A 3.5 year ministry from Passover of 28 AD would correspond to the April 32 AD crucifixion.



STAR OF DAVID ALIGNMENT

Another point of interest is that based on the research of John Charles Webb, a hexagram planetary alignment occurred during this time that presumes a commemoration of the Baptism of Christ just before a Passover and just before His 30th birthday. This time initiates the 3.5 year-long public ministry of Jesus as Messiah that leads to the Cross of Calvary. The unique planetary alignment is the 2nd that appears to 'bracket' the lifespan of Jesus Christ. The first such configuration occurred in March 2, -5 BC, from the purported date of Christ's birth in September 11, -3 BC.

ANASTRONOMICAL LIFESPAN

Another point of interest is that based on the Precession of the Equinox scale found in the Mazzaroth, the birth and death of Messiah was pegged to a 33° angle taken from the cardinal points of the Zodiac circle of time. Christ's birth confirms a Fall birth, Rosh HaShana mirrors His death in Spring during Passover. This pattern would coincide with the cycles of 'life and death' astronomically but in reverse order as the Fall signifies the descent of life into the dead of winter but that is the time Messiah was born. Likewise the Spring is a station of the beginning of 'life' to that goes into the summer but it was the time that Christ die.

Star of David Alignment

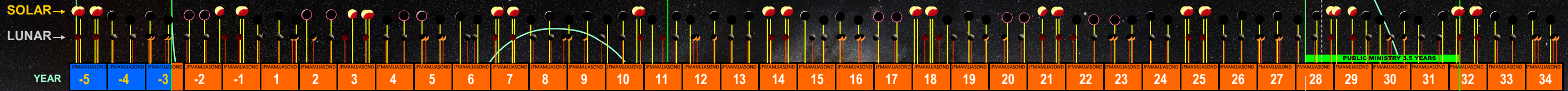

The Gospels state that Jesus was near 30 when He was baptized, suggesting that He was not yet turned 30 as that was the age that Rabbis could take on disciples and have a legitimate public ministry. His 1st act in the Synagogue was to proclaim the Year of Jubilee. If the Sept 11, -3 BC birth date is valid, Jesus had to wait until the Fall Feasts to commence His ministry of proclaiming the Kingdom and calling for the national repentance of Israel. Thus the 1st miracle of the marriage in Cana of turning the water into

SOME OBSERVATIONS

- The partial solar eclipses since Sep 11 -3 BC to 32 AD = 33. This corresponds to the age Christ was, 33 or on His 32rd year at the time of the crucifixion based on the year counts since the purported birth date.
- The 323 partial solar eclipses are demarked by 10 clustered separated by a factor of 7 years, i.e. $10 \times 7 = 70$ coefficient.
- There are a total of 18 total solar eclipses from Sep 11 -3 BC to 32 AD = a (6-6-6) pattern.
- If a phi ratio spiral pattern is superimposed on the timeline from Sep 11 -3 BC to 32 AD = a direct correspondence to the age of 13 that is the Bar Mitzvah or Age of Accountability.
- From the age of 13 to the time of the Baptism of Jesus is exactly 20 years.
- From the purported birth of Christ in Sep 11 -3 BC to 32 AD anniversary of 28 AD + 3.5 years = April of 32 AD the time of Christ's Death

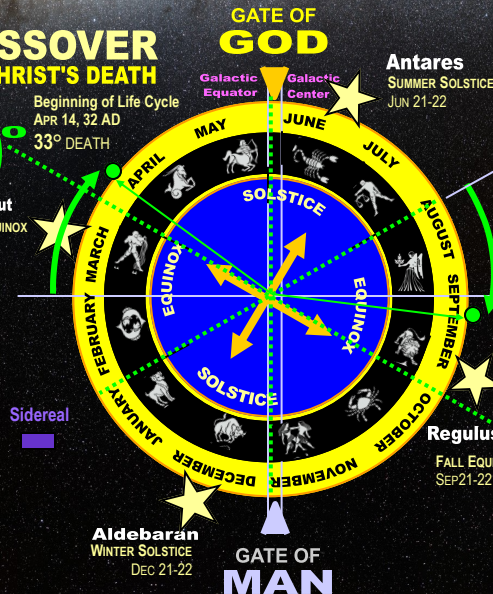
AGE OF ACCOUNTABILITY

This illustration possibly shows that perhaps the LORD's birth and death coincided to astronomical alignments precisely on Moedims or YHVH's appointed times. The number 33 is a sacred demarcation of time and space. Based on the supposition that Jesus was born on Sep 11, -3 BC then He would have been 33 years old in the year 32.

Based on the eclipse patterns, Jesus was 32 years old when crucified. He had a 3.5 year or 1260 day public ministry that commenced with the Baptism by John in the River Jordan around Passover of 28 AD. Exactly later on the Passover of April 14, 32 AD was a Wednesday, the 'midst' of the week and on a Blood Moon
