The Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Dean at 7:00 pm. The following Council members were present: Greg Garrett; Darci Jay; Tom Cavalier; Jeff Mohler

Absent: Ted Cavanaugh, Pat Kennedy

Others present: Debbie Runser, Fiscal Officer; Alan Michelson, Solicitor; Officer Hereda; Scott Gold, Zoning Inspector; Judy McKnight; Jane Hall

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Fire Chief Jeff Hall presented the monthly fire department report.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of October 5, 2016 was presented. Mrs. Jay moved to accept the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Garrett with all Council members voting "aye". Motion passed 4-0.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** The treasurer's report for the month ending October 31, 2016 was presented. Mr. Garrett moved to accept the treasurer report. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Jay with all Council members voting "aye". Motion passed 4-0.

**LIST OF BILLS:** The List of Bills was presented. Mrs. Jay moved to accept the list of bills. Mr. Mohler seconded the motion with all Council members voting "aye". Motion passed 4-0.

**CLERK'S REPORT:** Not enough council members at the meeting to pass the resolution for the amounts and rates from County Auditor a special meeting will be needed.

Mr. Michelson will bring an ordinance for purchasing from the Medina County Highway Engineer's to the next meeting.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** Officer Hereda worked 68 hours in October and Officer Furey turned in 4 hours from September..

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT:** Three cases in court this month, one is being handled by a special prosecutor.

The 3.0 mill current expense levy is coming up. First opportunity to place it on the ballot would be in May and an ordinance asking the County Auditor of the amount generated would need to be passed in December. Discuss of the need to replace the town hall. Mr. Cavalier estimated the construction costs would be approximately \$120 per square foot. Discussion of replacing only the back wall due its foundation problems.

Mr. Michelson presented an ordinance authorizing the operation of under speed vehicles for Council to consider due to the new regulations in the Ohio Revised Code section 4511.215. He asked that Council review the language of the ordinance bringing comments back next month. The vehicles would have to be licensed and insured. Some vehicles may need to be inspected by the Medina County Sheriff.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**HEALTH AND SAFETY: Greg Garrett:** Nothing to report. Mr. Gold had sent a letter to the homeowner at 337 Redfern to remove a dead tree which is causing a potential hazard but it is on private property and not in the right of way.

**ROADS: Tom Cavalier:** A truck came through and jetting the sewers.

**FINANCE: Darci Jay:** We did not get the OD&R Grant this year.

**SIGNS: Jeff Mohler:** Nothing to report.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Mr. Cavalier asked if we need to address the fire levy. Concerns about the Lafayette Fire levy passing and our costs going up, the closing of Fire Station 2 the amount in our Fire Fund. Mr. Michelson said that Lafayette Fire is saying that there are no plans to close Fire Station 2. Mrs. Runser put together a spreadsheet showing the Fire Fund estimated balance through 2020 (see attached).

**NEW BUSINESS:**

No new business.

**AUDIENCE RESPONSE/QUESTIONS:** None

There being no further business Mr. Garrett moved to close the meeting. Mr. Cavalier seconded the motion with all Council members voting "aye". Motion passed 4-0.

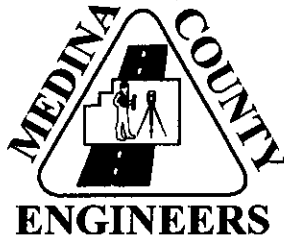

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF UNDERSPEED VEHICLES, GOLF CARTS, MINI-TRUCKS, UTILITY VEHICLES, LOW-SPEED VEHICLES, ALL-PURPOSE VEHICLES, ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND SNOWMOBILES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE VILLAGE SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN THIS ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLORIA GLENS PARK, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 2017, Village Council hereby authorizes the operation of underspeed vehicles, golf carts, mini-trucks, utility vehicles, low-speed vehicles, all-purpose vehicles, all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles on public streets and highways under the jurisdiction of the Village, provided all of the requirements set forth in this Ordinance are met.

1. "Such vehicles" means all of the various vehicles identified in the preceding paragraph of this Ordinance and the definitions for them shall be those set forth in the Ohio Revised Code.
2. Such vehicles may only be operated on streets and highways in the Village having an established speed limit not greater than thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
3. An owner who wishes to operate any of such vehicles on the public streets or highway of the Village must submit the vehicle to an inspection conducted by the Medina County Sheriff's Department and pass the equipment requirements established by the Ohio Director of Public Safety under Section 4513.02 of the Ohio Revised Code.
4. Such vehicles may be operated on Village streets and highways only if they are registered in accordance with Chapter 4503 of the Ohio Revised Code and are titled in accordance with Chapter 4505 of the Ohio Revised Code.
5. Any person operating any such vehicles on the public streets or highways under the jurisdiction of the Village of Gloria Glens Park in violation of any term or condition set forth in this Ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION II: The Fiscal Officer is directed to notify the Ohio Director of Public Safety in the manner the Director determines of the passage of this vehicle and the authorization for operation of such vehicles on Village streets and highways.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2017.
