On May 29, 2017, the City of Cisco will temporarily be changing back to free chlorine as the disinfectant in the City's treated drinking water. This temporary return to free chlorine is being made according to standard water treatment practices to help with water delivery system maintenance. The City plans to begin distributing water with free chlorine residual on May 29, 2017. The planned free chlorine maintenance period will last for 28 days. On June 25, 2017, the City will revert back to the chloramine disinfection which is the normal method used by the City of Cisco for water system disinfection.
