Ground Development

We are delighted that the FAW has agreed to provide us with £15,000 in response to our request for funding to further extend our parking area at the top of the Knock Field site. This will avoid the need for cars to park on the road outside of the site. This is also planned to prepare the site for the future changing room building.

We have also applied for match funding towards the costs from the Enhancing Pembrokeshire Fund. We should know by mid January if we have been successful. We would then hope to undertake the work within the early part of 2020.

Disability Football

For many years we have been providing coaching support to the Cleddau Warriors Disability Football Club and joining up with them for integrated football tournaments. This relationship will soon be strengthened further as both clubs have agreed in principle to the incorporation of the Cleddau Warriors into Clarbeston Road AFC. We hope that the formal arrangements will be completed in January and we will make an announcement when this takes place.
