Welcome to the 2019 pool season. If your account is in good standing (paid in full) you can obtain your pool tag by completing the attached registration form. Please complete and return by one of the following methods:

Your tag will be mailed to you once your Association account has been verified. One pool tag will allow all of your family members of Morningside Place Section 1 HOA in as well as one guest per family member present.

We ask that you please limit the use of the pool tag to your family members only. If your pool tag is lost or stolen, the cost for a replacement is \$25.00 per tag. There will be no exceptions to this rule. If your account balance is not paid in full, to the Association, you will need to contact APC Property Management.

Please be courteous of others while using the facilities. Please observe all posted rules for your safety and enjoyment. (See the top pools rules to know prior to entering the pool area on reverse side)

We also ask that you dispose of your trash in the trash receptacles provided. Most importantly, please remember the lifeguards are there for the safety of everyone, please show them respect.

TOP POOL RULES TO KNOW PRIOR TO ENTERING POOL AREA

1. Current pool tag is required to enter
2. A community homeowner with a current pool tag must accompany all guests. Only one guest is allowed per pool member.
3. Children twelve (12) years old and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult eighteen (18) years or older at all times.
4. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of underage children.
5. Only children six (6) years of age and under may use the wading pool. These children must be accompanied by an adult eighteen (18) years or older.
6. All swimmers must wear bathing suits- no cut-off jeans allowed.
7. Persons with open cuts and sores are not allowed in the pool.
8. No running or horseplay in the pool area.
9. No skateboards, bicycles, hover boards, etc. are allowed in the pool area.
10. No loud, abusive, or vulgar language.
11. No Pets, except service dogs allowed on premise.
12. No glass allowed in the pool area.
13. No food, drinks, or gum allowed in the pool.
14. No alcoholic beverages.
15. No diving.
16. Only lifeguards are allowed in/on the guard stand.
17. Patrons should not talk to the lifeguard on the stand unnecessarily.
18. Deposit all trash in the garbage cans provided- **Please don't litter.**
19. Failure to follow the rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area.
20. The lifeguards on duty have full authority to enforce all rules pertaining to safety at the pool.
21. Use of these facilities is at your own risk.
22. **ADDITIONAL POOL RULES ARE POSTED WITHIN THE POOL AREA.**
23. **IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY DIAL 911, EMERGENCY PHONE LOCATED ON WALL BETWEEN RESTROOMS.**
