

In January 2024, the Wilson Public Library in Cozad, NE, launches their tenth One Book One Cozad program with the selection of *The Floor of the Sky* by Pamela Carter Joern.

"In the Nebraska Sandhills, nothing is more sacred than the bond of family and land—and nothing is more capable of causing deep wounds. In Pamela Carter Joern's riveting novel The Floor of the Sky, Toby Jenkins, an aging widow, is on the verge of losing her family's ranch when her granddaughter Lila—a city girl, sixteen and pregnant—shows up for the summer. While facing painful decisions about her future, Lila uncovers festering secrets about her grandmother's past—discoveries that spur Toby to reconsider the ambiguous ties she holds to her embittered sister Gertie, her loyal ranch hand George, her not-so-sympathetic daughter Nola Jean, and ultimately, herself. Propelled by stark realism in breakneck prose, The Floor of the Sky

reveals the inner worlds of characters isolated by geography and habit. Pamela Carter Joern is the author of four works of fiction, published by the University of Nebraska Press: Toby's Last Resort, In Reach, The Plain Sense of Things, and The

Floor of the Sky. She has published short stories and essays in various literary journals. Joern has also written six plays that have been produced in the Twin Cities, including a musical, Alchemyra's Art. Pamela coedited Re-Membering and Re-Imagining. She taught writing at the Loft Literary Center for many years.

Joern won the Nebraska Book Award for Fiction and also the Alex Award from the Young Adult Library Service Association in 2007 for *The Floor of the Sky*. She lives in Minneapolis, is a graduate of United Theological Seminary, and holds an MFA from Hamline University.
