The District proposes to screen Rennen to decide whether an evaluation to determine eligibility for Early Childhood Special Education Services is needed.

As a parent, you have a right to request an evaluation at any time during the screening process. If Rennen is not suspected of having a disability, based on the results of screening, you still have the right to request an evaluation.

Please review the screening plan below. If you agree with this plan and with the district to conduct the screening, please sign and return the attached form.

1. Reasons that the district is proposing to screen your child:

Concern has been expressed about Rennen's speech development. Screening is a brief procedure that will give you information to determine your next steps. If the screening does indicate the need for an evaluation, the results of the screening will help that evaluation focus on the areas of concern.
