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Camp 7 Scholarship Guidelines

Please review the Camp 7 Scholarship application checklist and provide all required documentation to determine eligibility.

Applicants must submit a letter describing the need for financial assistance for Camp 7 (preferably from a 3rd party). In addition, the family must meet at least one of the following criteria and meet the income guideline of 150% of the Federal Poverty Level Guideline (FPLG):

- 1.) Children homeless or involved in foster care
- **2.**) Children of full-time working parents (minimum of 32 hours per week, provide at least three most recent paystubs from parent and/or guardian responsible for camp payment)
- **3.**) Children of a parent/parents with special needs receiving social security benefits (must provide documentation of benefits)
- **4.)** Children of part-time working parents (working 25-31 hours per week, provide at least three most recent paystubs from parent and/or guardian responsible for camp payment)
- **5.)** Children who are in the legal custody of their grandparents or other family members (must provide custody documents)
- **6.)** Children whose family receives TANF and/or SNAP benefits (must provide DHS documentation)

**Even if your family does not qualify for anything in the eligibility categories above, we still urge families to apply with a letter explaining the family's circumstances.
