A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 288 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions.




25 citations made 1 arrests and handled 31 enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is 3.6







On June 01, 2022, a **Wednesday**, at approximately 1256 hours, while on patrol in the "Brae Burn Valley West Contract" I Deputy R. Hernandez was performing routine patrol and law enforcement services when I observed a male that had similar descriptors of a suspect I was looking for involving a Discharge of a Firearm call that was reported at the bayou, behind Brae Burn Valley West Contract. Once contact was made, I immediately on viewed marijuana rolled up in a brown paper located on top of his left ear. Subject was detained and questioned about possibly being one out of two suspects I was looking for. Video footage was shown to the individual and immediately pointed out to one of the suspects in the video, being his youngest brother.

Both males were identified. Both individuals arrived on scene and detained. Youngest brother that was mentioned and second suspect were both charged for Discharging a Firearm within City limits. 3 Arrest made.

Case number was generated, and report was made. The patrol activity type is "PAT=F".

On June 8th, 2022, a **Wednesday**, at approximately 1446 hours, while on patrol in the "Brae Burn Valley West Contract" I Deputy R. Hernandez was performing routine patrol and law enforcement services, I was flagged down by a resident stating that an unknown person driving a white 2 door vehicle crash into two vehicles that were parked and continued to leave the area. Deputy canvassed the area and found a disabled vehicle park on the 10800 block of Gatlinburg Dr. Witness nearby informed me that a Hispanic male, possibly 20 years of age, got out the vehicle and ran from the vehicle.

After checking for a registered owner, I received an address that was 10 minutes away from the crash. I went to the location and was able to find a young Hispanic male fitting the description of the male that left the crash, seen by a witness. Hispanic male confessed to being the sole operator of the vehicle was detained. While patting down the suspect, the suspect had a loaded handgun on his waist band.

Charges were filed for FSGI and Unlawfully Carrying a Firearm. Suspect was then transported to the Harris County Jail and disabled vehicle was towed. Case number was generated and report was made. The patrol activity type is "PAT=Y".
