Our prayers have been answered!. Parishes can gather once more for Mass on Sundays and weekdays, Baptisms Weddings and funerals too can be celebrated in church albeit in simpler forms, fewer people and in compliance with regulations

So Sunday and Weekday Masses will commence at Holy Family and St Anne starting with

- Saturday 4th July 6.30pm Vigil Mass at Holy Family
- Sunday 5th July 8.45am Mass at St Annes
- Sunday 5th July 10.45am Mass at Holy Family
- Weekday Masses will commence at both churches w/c 6th July see listings for times in the weekly bulletin

We will have to observe social distancing, spaces in church will be limited, and some of our familiar rituals and ways of doing things in church will need to be different. There will be stewards at each church to direct what we need to do,

We remain in a stage of transition and the dispensation from attending Sunday Mass still holds. It will take time to get back to normal practice. This particularly applies to anyone who is feeling unwell, shielding or caring for someone in a vulnerable group you are not under an obligation to come to Mass. Fr Jim and his BAFTA nominated team will continue to stream Sunday Mass from St Anne at 8.45am and Holy Family on Sundays at 10.45am.

Participation in Divine worship and Liturgy is our privilege. It is ours not by right but by gift. These restrictions we experience are a consequence of us being citizens of a broader society, for whom we have a profound concern, and to whom we have a Divine Mission.
