# **ENTRY RULES**

- Enter in one class only and circle number desired on entry form. Parade Committee has the option to place entry in correct class if entered incorrectly. It is very important that we receive pages 5 and 6 of the entry packet at the Fair Office before the deadline.
- All entrants will obtain their parade entry number from Parade Committee members located at Hayfork High School parking lot at 8:00 am, Sunday August 11<sup>th</sup>. <u>Judging starts</u> at 8:30 a.m. promptly. Late arrivals might not be judged!
- This year we will be judging for BEST IN PARADE from all division winners. Each division winner will be picked from 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in each class. The Best in Parade winner will receive a rosette, trophy and \$100.
- All participants will form-up on Hayfork High School Parking lot by entry number after obtaining their number. State approximate length of truck and/or float on entry form.
- Parade route from Hayfork High School, along Hwy. #3 to Riverview Rd and back to Hayfork High School
- Parade participants will be judged at Hayfork High School before the parade begins and the winner will be announced during the parade as participants pass postal square (downtown).
- VEHICLE CLASSES 6 & 7 PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO BREAKING OF TRACTION OR EXCESSIVE LOUD NOISE OR ENTRY WILL BE ELIMINATED.
- Last minute entries may participate in the parade but will **not** be judged.
- CHILDREN 10 & UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED ON PARADE ROUTE BY AN ADULT.
- All decisions of the judges are final!
