There may be a couple of professionally filled sight screw holes, but they are very faint and its hard to determine if they are filled holes or just little nicks. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few scratches and scuffs on the limbs. This is a really nice world class recurve in excellent condition for its age.
