Sat, March 7 6:00 pm Difficulty 1	Snowshoe – Holmboe Forest State Natural Area Join Northwoods Land Trust (NWLTL) on Saturday, March 7 from 6:30-8 pm for a candlelight snowshoe at the Holmboe Conifer Forest State Natural Area in Rhinelander. Candlelight snowshoe outings are a great way to explore the night, plus we will have a nearly full moon to help guide us. Participants will be snowshoeing about 0.75-1 mile over uneven terrain. Depending on conditions, participants may wish to walk and consider using traction devices on boots, poles and a flashlight. Optional opportunity afterwards at Rhinelander Brewing Company to warm up. Please register in advance by calling the NWLTL office at (715) 479-2490 or email Troy . To find the Holmboe parking lot, it is located behind Riverview Hall at 903 Boyce Dr., Rhinelander 54501. From the intersection of Hwy 17S and Hwy 8 on the south side of Rhinelander, go northeast on Boyce Dr. about 0.3 mile to 903 Boyce Dr. Parking and trail access is in the back lot of the Riverview Hall Student Housing building.
