Police reserves will assist our sworn police officers with traffic control, training, parades, Tower Days activities, waiting for tow trucks, disasters, storms, bike patrol, animal control, football games, large events, and other duties requested.

Police Reserve Applicants Criteria:

- Must be 18 years of Age
- Be a United States Citizen
- Possess a valid MN Driver's License and a good driving record
- Possess a high school diploma or equivalent
- Ability to communicate orally and in writing
- Be in good physical and mental health without any disabilities restricting body functions.
- Pass oral interview and review board
- Submit to a criminal history and background check
- Complete the reserve academy and training that we provide
- Complete a probationary period
